In the Gospel today, Jesus makes mention of the Old Testament time in which the people grumbled against God and rejected Him. God then sent serpents who bit the people and poisoned them. The custom of the Seven Sundays of St Joseph



In this *Year of St. Joseph*, let us pray on each of the seven Sundays leading up to his feast one of his sorrows with an accompanied joy. This week take some time to think of that seventh sorrow and joy.

Many of you are familiar with the Sleeping St. Joseph devotion, which Pope Francis has promoted for several years. Now that we are celebrating the Year of St. Joseph and his feast day is upon us, what a perfect time to embrace this beloved

devotion. It involves obtaining a statue of St. Joseph sleeping, which can easily be found online or in stores that sell Catholic goods. After writing personal intentions on a slip of paper, tuck it under the statue (I put mine under his pillow!). By doing so you are entrusting St. Joseph, our great intercessor, to bring your intentions to God.

In Father Donald Calloway's book *Consecration to St. Joseph; The Wonders of Our Spiritual Fathers*, he includes the following beautiful prayer in the section he devotes to the importance and power of St. Joseph's sleep:

O Saint Joseph, you are a man greatly favored by the Most High. The angel of the Lord appeared to you in dreams, while you slept, to warn you and guide you as you cared for the Holy Family. You were both silent and strong, a loyal and courageous protector. Dear Saint Joseph, as you rest in the Lord, confident of his absolute power and goodness, look upon me. Please take my need into your heart, dream of it, and present it to your Son. Help me then, good Saint Joseph, to hear the voice of God, to arise, and act with love. I praise and thank God with joy. Saint Joseph, I love you. Amen.

**Wisdom of God in the Lives of the Saints
by Fr. Dominic**

"Most men wish to obtain the Kingdom without trouble, or pain, or sweat, and that is a thing impossible."
-St. Macarius the Great

People aspire for greatness in hopes of achieving noble things. Rightly so, the good things in life are strongly encouraged to be pondered upon and even pursued. Saint Paul told the Philippians that "whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise..."(Phil. 4:8) they should think about. While most people do not shy away from daring to hope for the nobler things in life, they fail to persevere and put in the effort. This is because they lack the fortitude to undergo and overcome the hardships which so often can come their way. Let us apply what Saint Paul told the Philippians to our own lives. Heaven is what is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, gracious and worth praise and we want to go there! In fact, we were made to go there... but it is on us to do everything we can, on earth, in order to attain this! St. Macarius reminds us that people desire to obtain the Kingdom without putting in the work. If we truly desire heaven, we must have a real and living relationship with God. We cannot simply just say "I love God and I know He loves me, too". We must work at building our relationships with Him. Therefore, we have to ask ourselves, "Am I giving God enough time today?" "Am I turning away from sin so that I may grow closer to Him?". If we are unable to bring ourselves to prayer, turn away from sin, and deny ourselves, we have to work harder. Nothing worth having is going to be easy! Jesus is the most perfect example of all of this- He suffered an excruciating agony in the Garden. His way to Calvary shows us His pain, sweat, and Most Precious Blood which was shed for us on the cross. 'For the sake of the joy that lay before Him He endured the cross, despising its shame, and has taken His seat at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider how He endured such opposition from sinners, in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart.' In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood' (Heb. 12:2-4). All of this was done for the Love of His Father so that we may be able to attain the Kingdom. Whether it is comfortable and convenient, or uncomfortable and inconvenient, we have to realize God wills our sanctification and happiness. He knows the best means for us to attain that perfection, however, we must bear in mind that this will not necessarily be without struggles. May the Holy Spirit illuminate our minds to see a glimpse of the breadth, the width, and length of God's glory in the Passion of Jesus Christ so that our hearts may be strengthened to love Him more intensely, eagerly, and wholeheartedly without reservation.




