

The Divine Mercy Chaplet



Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet daily is a beautiful way to enter into the great mercy of God and is a powerful source of consolation and hope for all who trust in Jesus and in his

messages to Saint Faustina. Praying the Chaplet, which is typically prayed using rosary beads, only takes a few minutes. It is especially good to pray it at the three o'clock hour, the hour of mercy, but can also be prayed anywhere at any time. Personally, I have found great peace praying this chaplet intentionally for those who have died and for those who are dying; the graces that can be received from trusting in God's mercy are awe inspiring. Here is a brief overview for how to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. There are also many sources available that will provide a more detailed explanation on Divine Mercy and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. A great place to start would be the National Shrine of Divine Mercy in Stockbridge, Mass. Their website is: www.shrineofmercy.org.

Optional Opening Prayer: *You expired Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.*

Beginning Prayer (Repeat three times): *O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!*

Pray the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed

For each of the five decades – On the “Our Father” bead of the rosary pray: *Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.*

On each of the ten “Hail Mary” beads of the rosary pray: *For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

Concluding Prayer (repeat three times): *Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

Optional Closing Prayer: *Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.*

May this devotion bring you as much peace and comfort as it has brought me. Easter blessings and best wishes to all,



This is the simplicity and sweetness of prayer itself! When we truly enter into prayer, we are abandoning ourselves to the Divine Embrace! Since prayer is an act of the soul whereby the mind and the heart are lifted up to God, when we bring ourselves to prayer we are not only cooperating with, but also disposing ourselves to, the graces of God. In other words, when we pray, we avail ourselves of the graces that God wills to infuse in us and allow them to penetrate every fiber of our being. Immersed in the bath of graces, we will experience the immensity of Divine Charity and Goodness. This echoes what Jesus offered to the Samaritan woman at the well when He said: *“the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life”* (John 4:14b). This spring of water is the freshness of grace overflowing from prayer, which rejuvenates the soul and lifts it toward God Himself.

Mercy comes from the Latin, *misericordia*. *Miser* means, misery. *Cordia* means, heart. It literally means misery heart. To have *misericordia* is to have a heart for someone who is in misery or heartfelt compassion. The word compassion means to bear another's suffering. Mercy is heartfelt compassion. It is the ability for a person's heart to take on and bear the "misery heart" of another. Every act of forgiveness is an act of mercy, but not every act of mercy is an act of forgiveness. When we forgive people, we acknowledge that they wronged us and have mercy on them. When we have mercy on others, through the corporal and spiritual works of mercy (feeding the hungry, visiting the sick, instructing the ignorant, forgiving wrongs) we don't forgive them, but acknowledge they are suffering and in need of mercy.


