

They are:



Wisdom of God in the Lives of the Saints
by Fr. Dominic

“To be pure, to remain pure, can only come at a price, the price of knowing God and loving Him enough to do His will. He will always give us the strength we need to keep purity as something as beautiful for Him.”

-Saint Teresa of Calcutta

Purity flows from a life that is rightly ordered. A person is said to be rightly ordered when they act according to the right reason, which is the nature of man, a rational creature. The ability to know the truth and to choose to act in accordance with it for the good of the human person is what sets man apart from, and above, the material world and other visible creatures. For this reason, man is called to seek the higher goods in life while avoiding things that are not compatible with who he is, or below his dignity. Then, he must act in a manner that is proper and fitting to his nature so that he may flourish. The psalmist succinctly expresses this notion in these words, *“I study the way of integrity...I act with integrity of heart within my household. I do not allow into my presence whatever is base. I hate wrongdoing. I will have no part of it”* (Psalm 101:2-3). Since God is Truth and Goodness Itself, and possesses all perfections without qualification or limit, man is perfectly ordered when God takes the first place in his life. This is why the first and greatest commandment is to *“love God with all your heart, with all your mind, with all your soul, and with all your strength”* so that by loving Him who is perfect, man becomes pure as He is pure. In order to remain pure, man must not only love God but also remain in Him, so that he will be able to love everything else proportionate to its dignity, not an ounce more or less, and detest all things which do not belong to God.

“I Thirst” is a program by the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, which came to fruition from a vision Sr. Josephine had about her recently deceased father. Her father, a Catholic man, shared the little he had with those who needed it. Sr. Josephine wanted to honor his memory by serving the poor in collaboration with our St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Sr. Josephine grew up in a village in Urualla, Nigeria. The people are very poor in Urualla, lacking the basic necessities of life ~ food and water. Think about that for a moment—in Urualla there is no running water in the homes. They rely on the rainy season to sustain them. Our goal is to address each of the major needs they face in the village.

In the coming weeks, we will begin to explain what we have already accomplished and what our mission is for the future to serve the needs of all the villagers who live in Urualla.






