

I THIRST . . .

The members of the I Thirst team consist of some members of the board of St. Vincent de Paul here at St. Mary's, Sr. Josephine, and some young adult volunteers from our parish community. There is a lot of enthusiasm and excitement found in our newly formed group looking to serve God through our sisters and brothers in Uralla, Nigeria.

The I Thirst team will raise it's own money to support all requests coming from Nigeria. All donations made for this cause will go to St. Vincent de Paul, which will be responsible for distributing funds for assistance. No donations made to St. Vincent de Paul at St. Mary's in Dedham for assistance here in Dedham will be used for the I Thirst projects for Nigeria.

There is extreme poverty and many needs in Nigeria which was highlighted in last week's bulletin. Before we were able to put our I Thirst team together and raise any money, a request was presented by Sr. Josephine for consideration. Three young girls in Nigeria wanted to attend their local Catholic school, but their parents could not afford the tuition. Immediately after Sr Josephine presented the case, three members of the St. Vincent de Paul conference at St. Mary's offered to pay the tuition with their own money so the girls could go to school. The three board members ended up paying the tuition and buying uniforms and some school supplies for the three girls. Since then we have received two reports that the students are happy and doing well in school.



Wisdom of God in the Lives of the Saints by Fr. Dominic

"We, as Catholics are not permitted to believe anything of our own will, nor to choose what someone has believed of his. We have God's apostles as authorities, who did not themselves of their own wills choose anything of what they wanted to believe, but faithfully transmitted to the nations, the teachings of Christ." - Saint Isidore of Seville

Saint Isidore reminds us that as Catholics in order to walk the narrow path towards heaven, we must first humble ourselves and admit "we are not permitted to believe anything of our own will". At first glance, someone outside of the Faith reading this might say "Where is the freedom in that? I thought we all have free will". The truth of the matter is that we actually have complete freedom when we abandon our feeble wills to His. This act of submission requires humility which the Catechism defines as "the virtue by which a Christian acknowledges that God is the author of all good". In our humility, we recognize we will not know nor be able to understand everything. However, in His Goodness, God has provided us with Sacred Tradition that has been handed down through Apostolic Succession as a way to help us. Saint Isidore continues on to tell us that God's apostles did not choose anything of their own. Instead they "faithfully transmitted to the nations, the teaching of Christ". We too must assent to the totality of the Deposit of Faith and continue to recognize, in our humility, that we are servants of Christ. Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us the great commission when He said, "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19-20). By our humility, others will know that we are true disciples of Jesus Christ because we learn from Him who "came down from heaven not to do [His] own will but the will of the One who sent [Him]" (John 6:38).



Sr. Josephine's last Mass will be on Sunday, May 30th at 11:00 am. She will begin a residency at Morristown Medical Center in New Jersey. It has been a pleasure having her as a part of our parish community. She will be sorely missed.


