St. Matthias

Matthias had been traveling with Jesus since his baptism by John in the Jordan river, and was likely nominated for his experience with the Lord and his holiness.

Some traditional sources claim he was martyred by beheading, which is why he is depicted here with a short sword. He began his ministry in Judea, and Greek tradition holds that he Christianized Cappadocia, which is in modern day Turkey. His feast day is on May 14th.

A Faith-filled Olympian

In a recent *Catholic News Agency (CNA)* Instagram post I read about Grace McCallum, an eighteen year old gymnast from Minnesota who just made the US Olympic gymnastics team. For such a young woman, the extent to which her strong Catholic faith helps her handle the pressures of being an elite athlete is inspiring.

The post points out that Grace does not travel anywhere without her rosary and a special cross which was given to her by her grandmother, and the whole family relies on the power of prayer to help keep Grace focused during competitions. Because of the toughness of the sport, her mother attests "that nothing means more to her daughter than people reaching out saying they are praying for her."

In another online post (*deseret.com*), writer Trent Wood quotes McCallum as saying that in Tokyo "I'll really be leaning on my faith...my dad is sending me a couple of prayers to say before each practice in the morning. I think that will be really helpful to keep me at peace and calm while I'm there." In the same post Grace's coach describes her as "very quiet and shy," but it seems that her faith helps her believe in herself and her God given abilities. Grace says of her faith, "It has helped me a ton...it has kept me grounded in who I am. I don't think I've changed at all (since making the Olympic team) and I don't want to change."

In our world it is so prevalent for athletes and other high profile individuals to become role models for others. It appears that Grace is a young woman worthy of that role. Good luck in Tokyo Grace, I'll be praying for you!

Wisdom of God in the Lives of the Saints

"The judgments of God have terrified me. The darkness of death has overtaken me, and the fear of hell has invaded me. But in solitude I will expect thy consolation, and in my chamber I will wait for thy mercy."

In this beautiful psalter of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Bonaventure evokes every Catholic to recourse to the protection of Our Lady in consideration of *The Four Last Things*. The Church teaches that *The Four Last Things* are Death, Judgment, Heaven, and Hell. Among the list of concerns in life, every individual should meditate frequently on the topic of eschatology — the study of the end of time. The purpose of this is not to cause the individual to despair nor become despondent, but instead, help the person see the seriousness of what lies ahead and how they can prepare for it. Hopefully, in humility, the person will realize how terrifying it is and not dare to rely on their own strength for when it comes time to face death and the judgments of God. The easiest way to evade Hell, and the quickest way to Heaven, is to remain united to Our Lady. Under Her Immaculate Mantle, one can hope to stand firm in the darkness of death and the just judgments of the Almighty God, because She, Who is full of grace alone, can dispel the darkness. She is the most pleasing to God! Thus, in all things, may we always find ourselves close to Our Lady, and never without Her, as we journey in and through this Valley of Tears.

Make that *two* Friday Fun Nights in the books! Hopefully you have all recovered from the cornhole games with Fr. Wayne and Fr. Dominic. They took their training pretty seriously... If you lost to them and their partners, know it was because of the hours of practice they were putting in outside their daily prayers and offerings of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Our **next Friday Fun Night** will be a trip to **Castle Island!** We will be leaving the back lot at **6:00 p.m.** Please let me know if you will be joining us no later than **Wednesday (7/21).**

Last week, I encouraged you all to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet while meditating on the following: **“O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!”**. By doing this, we begin the process of entering into more of a meditative form of prayer which is the second of the three forms of prayer we have discussed at Pizza & Prayer (vocal, meditative, contemplative).

Before we can really enter into mediation, we must first work on **being comfortable in the silence**. This will help us continue building upon **meditative prayer**. Just like with anything we desire to be good at (sports, art, singing, etc.), **we must be disciplined**. Your **challenge this week** is to **make 3 minutes of silence a priority** in the morning when you wake up and another 3 minutes before going to bed.



Mother Theresa said *“In the silence of the heart God speaks. If you face God in prayer and silence, God will speak to you. Then you will know that you are nothing. It is only when you realize your nothingness, your emptiness, that God can fill you with Himself. Souls of prayer are souls of great silence.”*
