From the Pastor's Desk . . .



This weekend in the Gospel of Mark, Jesus, by means of the prophesy of Isaiah, offers this sharp condemnation to the Pharisees and scribes: *"This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me . . ."* He notes that they follow all of the external precepts of the laws and the traditions; yet, interiorly they are only going through the motions. In other words, the teachings of the Law and the Prophets have not taken root in their hearts. They operate out of a desire to be seen performing all the deeds and works of the faith; however, they are not living the faith. For us, it becomes increasingly easy to follow the precepts but it is altogether different to live them. Today, live your faith. Examine your minds and hearts to see if you have allowed the teachings of Christ, communicated through the Church and the Sacraments, to take root in your lives. To know the faith and to live the faith are two different things. It is extremely important to do both ~ know and live the faith today!

St. Phillip
The Apostle Philip was one of Christ's first disciples, called soon after his Master's baptism in the Jordan. Tradition tells us that he was a missionary in the regions of Galatia and Phrygia; and, in Phrygia, the Apostle was crucified and then stoned to death. His feast day is May 3rd.

To portray Philip, a basket of loaves of bread can be used to symbolize his part in the feeding of the five thousand (Mark 6:41). This story was also present at the feeding of the five thousand (John 6:4-14). When Jesus asked Philip, "Where are we to buy bread for these people to eat?" Philip replied, "Two hundred denarii would not buy enough bread for each of them to get a little" yet Jesus did not rebuke him for any lack of faith.



COLLECT PRAYER

Perhaps like me you have heard the term Collect Prayer many times and seen the weekly Collect Prayers in the front of our missals, but have not fully understood the significance of this element in the liturgy. The Collect Prayer follows the Introductory Prayers and is the official name for the priest's opening prayer. Listen for when the priest says, "Let us pray," and then notice that there is a short period of silence. This is very significant; in that silence we are to form intentions for the Mass individually, which the priest then "collects" and presents to God through the Collect Prayer. As the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (no. 54) says:

"Next the priest calls upon the people to pray and everybody, together with the priest, observes a brief silence so that they may become aware of being in God's presence and might call to mind their intentions. Then the priest pronounces the prayer usually called "The Collect."

This is a reminder that every moment of the Mass is important and intentional – the words, gestures and moments of silence are all imbued with meaning. It's also a reminder that the congregation has a major role to play both in the responses spoken out loud and the ones we offer in silence.

The Collect Prayer from this past Sunday was particularly timely and can be a source of peace during these challenging times:

"O God, who causes the minds of the faithful to unite in a single purpose, grant your people to love what you command and to desire what you promise, that, amid the uncertainties of this world, our hearts may be fixed on that place where true gladness is found. Through our Lord, Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God for ever and ever. Amen."

Just as the body takes great delight in food and drink, the soul enjoys the fruits of divine grace. Food and drink not only give health to the body, but they also strengthen it to undergo laborious work. Similarly, divine grace produces "charity, joy, peace, patience, benignity (or kindness), goodness, longanimity (or long-suffering), mildness (or gentleness), faith, modesty, continency (or self-control), and chastity" (Galatians 5:22-23) in the soul, in order that it may proclaim the glory of God at all times.

Unfortunately, we spend our lives on many vain pursuits, only to find ourselves left dry and empty handed. Meanwhile, the treasure of divine grace is too often being overlooked and underappreciated. Moreover, it is seldomly sought after with great eagerness which results in the detriment of the soul. Remember that God has made us for Himself, Who is our happiness. This fount of life is found at the Crucifixion of Jesus Christ and in the Blessed Sacrament where all graces are dispensed without measure. May we come kneeling before Him in adoration and worship so that our souls may be filled with the plenitude of divine graces.




