SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN TO PROTECT BORN-ALIVE INFANTS THIS WEEKEND AND THE NEXT

Did you know that under the Roe Act (different from Roe v. Wade) passed last year by the Massachusetts Legislature, a child born alive in Massachusetts has no legal right to self-sustaining medical care? A signature campaign is underway to propose a law protecting children born alive, particularly during an abortion. If/when enough signatures (85,000) are gathered, the initiative petition question will appear on the November 2022 ballot. This proposed law would require all reasonable steps in keeping with good medical practice be taken to preserve the life of a child born alive. Parishioners will be collecting signatures during the month of October. Please consider signing this very important petition.

Panis Angelicus

Recently I was at a neighboring parish for Mass and the Communion Hymn was the beautiful composition *Panis Angelicus* (Latin for Bread of Angels), which is sung primarily within liturgical worship but is also performed in secular settings by some of the world's most gifted vocalists and musicians. As the Boston Archdiocese is still celebrating the Year of the Eucharist, here is a brief overview of this time-honored hymn:

The lyrics, originally written in Latin, are from a verse of the sacred work *Sacris Solemniis*, which was written by St. Thomas Aquinas at the request of Pope Urban IV in the 13th century. It was written to honor the feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for the Body of Christ), which celebrates the tradition and belief in the body and blood of Jesus Christ and His Real Presence in the Eucharist.

There are many melodies for this hymn, both ancient and modern. The one we may be most familiar with was composed by Cesar Franck from Belgium in the late 19th century.

Here is the English translation for *Panis Angelicus*:

Heavenly Bread
That becomes the bread of all mankind;
Bread from the angelic host
That is the end of all imaginings.
Oh, miraculous thing!
This body of God will nourish
Even the poorest,
The most humble of servants.
Even the poorest,
The most humble of servants.

St. Thomas Aquinas, thank you for blessing us with this timeless work of faith. St. Thomas, pray for us!

Wisdom of God in the Lives of the Saints

“Do not have Jesus Christ on your lips, and the world in your heart.” -Saint Ignatius of Antioch


