***From the Pastor's Desk . . .***



This weekend, as we enter into the Second Sunday of Advent, we make a journey into the desert. It is there that we encounter John the Baptist. He is there “*proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.*” Furthermore, he is that voice crying out “*prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths.*” I encourage each of you to heed the Baptist’s call. Prepare well for the coming of Christ. The second candle of the Advent Wreath is lit, and we are coming closer to the great celebration of His birth. Take the time *now* to slow down and think of the importance of His birth in your lives. In the Church, we have two great feasts that incapsulate the entirety of the message and mission of Christ. They are Easter and Christmas. Both of these significant feasts have a period of preparation attached to them. For Easter, we have forty days to prepare in a penitential manner ~ *Lent*. For Christmas, we have a period of four weeks to prepare with anticipation ~ *Advent*. So here we are, in the Advent Season to do just that; namely, with joyful anticipation let us prepare and wait for the birth of the Christ. Last week, I suggested a few spiritual exercises you can do in this season to prepare. I feel they are worth repeating: attend Mass (daily and weekend), make a good confession, pray a holy hour in the Perpetual Adoration Chapel, pray the Rosary with your family, pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy with the parish family (daily at 3:00 p.m. in the Chapel), read the Bible, or partake in a fast. In the words of John the Baptist: “*prepare the way of the Lord.*”

It could be said that prayer and penance are two sides of the same coin in the spiritual life. They are the two Ps which dispose of a soul to a transforming union with God. On one hand, penance helps the soul to detach and empty itself, not only from sinful and disordered things, but even from the lower goods that may not be most fitting to the soul’s well-being. On the other hand, prayer opens the heart and mind of the soul to God. It prepares the heart and mind to receive God’s goodness. In other words, prayer helps the soul to wait patiently and attentively on God without being drawn away by the lower goods. The practices of intense prayers and penance will certainly help a soul to prepare for Christ’s twofold comings, namely Christmas and His second coming. 


## SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Last Sunday, our Life Teen Program rang in the **Liturgical New Year** with a **New Year's party** down in the Life House after Supper for the Soul. We enjoyed listening to music, playing games, and of course watching **the ball drop!** Afterwards, Vinny and Elizabeth led a Life Night on Advent. Teens learned that “ad” means “to” and “vino” means “on your way”. **Advent literally means “on your way to Christ”!** So what does Advent mean for us? What does it look like? In this season of waiting and preparation, **God is calling us to get to know Him in a more intimate and personal way.** We read “*And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us*” (John 1:14). God sent His Only Son to this world, on a cold winter night, in order to save us from our sins and to restore our relationship with Our Heavenly Father. In the Advent wreath, **the first purple candle burns reminding us of the hope** we can all have in knowing Jesus is coming again.



Now, we are seven days closer to Jesus' coming and the second purple candle is burning in addition to the first! **The theme of the second week of Advent is faith** as we are reminded to **continue preparing the way for the Lord.** We read “*A voice of one calling in the wilderness, ‘Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him. Every valley shall be filled in, every mountain and hill made low. The crooked roads shall become straight, the rough ways smooth. And all people will see God’s salvation.’*” (Luke 3: 4-6). We can ask ourselves “How do I prepare the way for the Lord?”. **One of the best ways to prepare ourselves to receive Jesus is to first receive His love for us in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.** In 7 Secrets of

Confession, author Vinny Flynn explains “*We don’t go to confession; we are called to this encounter with Jesus — the one whom we love because He has first loved us. Trusting in this love, we enter into this sacramental encounter, called by name to change our hearts and our lives, and become who we already are in the mind of God*” (128). I encourage you all to go and meet Jesus in the confessional! As Core member Jamie once shared at a Life Night “I feel most ‘Jamie’ when I come out from Confession”.


