### *From the Pastor's Desk . . .*



In the very opening line of the Gospel this weekend, Christ challenges us to show love to our enemies and repay those who wish us harm with acts of mercy and forgiveness. This truly is a moment in which Christ is calling us to go beyond what we may be accustomed to doing and to consider what God would expect from us. Far too often revenge, anger, and/or retaliation dictate how people act and react when confronted by an enemy or one who displays hostility. Yet, today Christ is telling us ~ no, rather, He is **commanding** us to love. Again listen to His words: *"love your enemies . . . pray for those who mistreat you . . . give and don't demand it back . . . lend expecting nothing in return . . . stop judging . . . forgive.* In other words, He is asking us to go the extra distance in our relationships with others. When we do so, we give them an opportunity to have an encounter with our merciful and loving God through our actions. Think about that for a minute. When we show mercy and love to others they encounter the love and mercy of God who is acting through us. Showing love, forgiveness, and mercy can make a huge difference in others' lives and in our lives as well. So, do what Christ tells you today and make a difference in a world so marred by violence, hatred, and anger.

### *The Custom of the Seven Sundays of St Joseph*



A long-standing pious tradition in preparing for the Feast of St. Joseph on March 19th is to dedicate the seven Sundays prior to his feast to his seven sorrows and seven joys. This week is the fourth sorrow and joy for reflection:

**4th Sorrow:** *"Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, 'Behold, this child is set for the rise and fall of many, a sign that is spoken against ... that thoughts out of many hearts may be revealed.'"* (Lk 2:34-35)

**4th Joy:** *"For my eyes have seen thy salvation which thou hast prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles."* (Lk 2:30-32)

*“Celebrating the “Chair” of Peter...means attributing a strong spiritual significance to it and recognizing it as a privileged sign of the love of God, the eternal Good Shepherd, who wanted to gather his whole Church and lead her on the path of salvation.”*

Pope Benedict XVI, General Audience, February 22, 2006.

### **The Chair of St. Peter the Apostle**

On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, Tuesday of this week, we celebrate the feast day of The Chair of St. Peter the Apostle. This feast recognizes that there is a relic of St. Peter's chair, known as the *Cathedra Petri*, located in the apse of St. Peter's Basilica. In addition, the celebration focuses on the authority Jesus Christ himself gave to St. Peter and his successors, including our Holy Father Pope Francis.

The website [mycatholic.life](http://mycatholic.life) offers the following explanation of the deep meaning of this feast day:

“Authority attaches to the Office of St. Peter and endows its occupant with the charisms promised by Christ to Saint Peter. And this charism will endure until the sun sets for the last time. As long as there is a Church, it will teach objective truth, and objective truth requires objective leadership. And that objective leadership, symbolized in the Chair of St. Peter, is directed towards unity. One Lord, One faith. One Shepherd. One flock. The united fabric of the Church, so fought for, so torn, so necessary, is worth honoring in the liturgy of the Church.”

*God in Heaven, we thank You for the ordered community of faith we enjoy in the Catholic Church. Your chosen vicar, Saint Peter, guided this early Church and guides Her still, ensuring that we remain one, holy, catholic, and apostolic until the end of time. Continue to grace Your Church with the unity so necessary to accomplish Her mission on earth.*

### **Wisdom of God in the Lives of the Saints**

*“Temperance is simply a disposition of the mind which binds the passion.”*

—Saint Thomas Aquinas

Temperance is one of the four cardinal virtues which “moderates the attraction of pleasures and provides balance in the use of created goods” (CCC, 1809). Since man is a composition of body and soul, there are many material and physical goods the body enjoys. While the bodily goods, in and of themselves, are not evil, they can lead us to sin when they are enjoyed in an excessive, or even disordered, manner. For example, it is good to eat delicious food and drink fine wine. However, one should not over indulge in eating and drinking as that would result in gluttony and drunkenness. For this reason, Saint Paul firmly reminded us that “*the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord...glorify and bear God in your body...whether you eat or drink, or whatsoever else you do, do all to the glory of God*” (1 Cor. 6:13, 20; 10:31). It is important to bear in mind that by growing in the virtue of temperance, one is better able to control their instincts and desires “*within the limits of what is honorable*” (CCC, 1809). As a rational creature, right reason should always govern man's actions and direct them accordingly for the well-being of the whole person. God created the fine things of this world and has given us stewardship over them so that we may use and enjoy them for His Glory. May we strive to grow in temperance!

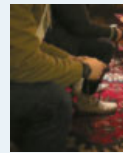

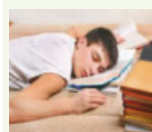

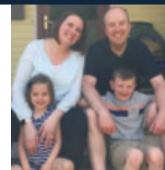
