

**A NOTE FROM MUSIC DIRECTOR
PETER BROCKMANN**

This Sunday’s Gospel recounts the powerful moment when the risen Christ appears to the disciples, and Thomas—who had doubted—comes to believe: “My Lord and my God!” (John 20:28). This encounter gives rise to Jesus’ blessing: “Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.” In other words, blessed are we—modern disciples—who walk not by sight but by faith.

That’s why today’s hymn, *We Walk by Faith*, is such a fitting response. Written by Henry Alford in the 19th century and set to the tune *Shanti* by Marty Haugen, the hymn expresses the journey of discipleship in the absence of physical proof. It speaks directly to the heart of Thomas’ story—and ours—where belief isn’t rooted in visible signs, but in the witness of others and the trust that grows through grace.

Each verse gently acknowledges our human struggle: “We may not touch His hands and side, nor follow where He trod,” but affirms that Christ is truly present and invites our faith anyway. The refrain echoes our prayer: “Increase our faith!” It’s a reminder that faith is a gift and a journey.

As we sing this hymn today at the Preparation of the Gifts, may it be both a comfort and a challenge. In a world that often demands proof, we are called to walk in trust—supported by Scripture, the sacraments, and each other—toward the One who lovingly calls us to believe.

Let us sing!


