



#### **SYNOD ON SYNODALITY**

#### From the Archdiocese of Boston

Over the next several years, the Church around the world will be participating in a process called the *Synod on Synodality*. The Holy Father will be meeting with bishops from across the globe in 2023 to discuss ways of improving the process by which the Church on all levels is open to hearing the voices of people from all walks of life.

Upcoming steps include:

- Discussions in the Presbyteral Council, Archdiocesan Pastoral Council, and Parish Pastoral Councils and Parish Finance Councils
- Focus groups in various ministries, religious communities, and demographic populations
  - 5 regional sessions that will be open to the public.
- The collection of all of the feedback, and its compilation into a ten-page document which will be submitted to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in April of 2022.
- A closing liturgy at the Cathedral in late April of 2022.

In this process, we hope to be able to make some contribution to the global conversation on synodality.



#### **HYMN OF THE DAY**

Both the text, "We Three Kings of Orient Are" and its corresponding tune, KINGS OF ORIENT, were written by John H. Hopkins (1820-1891). He published it in his Carols, Hymns and Songs (New York, 1863). Hopkins was a native of Pittsburgh, studied law in Vermont, and theology in New York City. He was active in the New York Ecclesiological Society, the American counterpart of John Mason Neal's Cambridge society. He was ordained an Episcopal priest and served parishes in New York state and Pennsylvania.






