ANNUAL REPORT

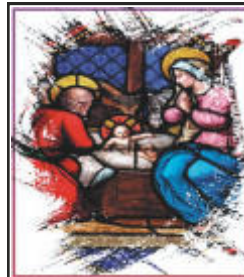

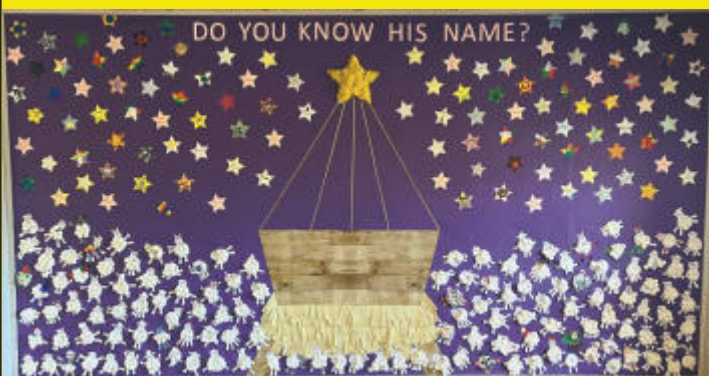

Our Grade 1 – 8 students just finished our Advent Bulletin Board! The theme was “Do you know His name?”. For young children, under 10: *Adventure Catechism*, each 20 min segment in a cartoon format introduces children to one aspect of the Catholic faith.

For teens and adults: *Journey Through Advent with Bishop Robert Baron*, a series of homilies by Bishop Baron on the Cycle C scripture readings in Advent.

To access videos, click ON DEMAND, then use the WATCH heading to find and stream these and other videos. 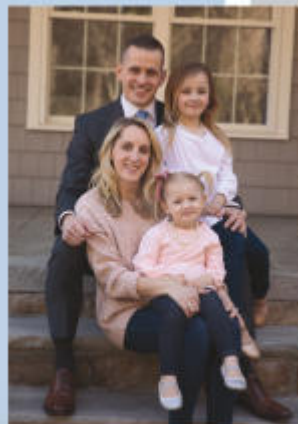
