While change is often difficult, we all want Sister Ann to be safe and appropriately cared-for. Her superiors have decided that she will relocate in mid-February.

Before leaving, we want to make sure that we have an opportunity to convey to Sister Ann how important she has been to the life of the parish and to thank her for her many years of dedicated service. 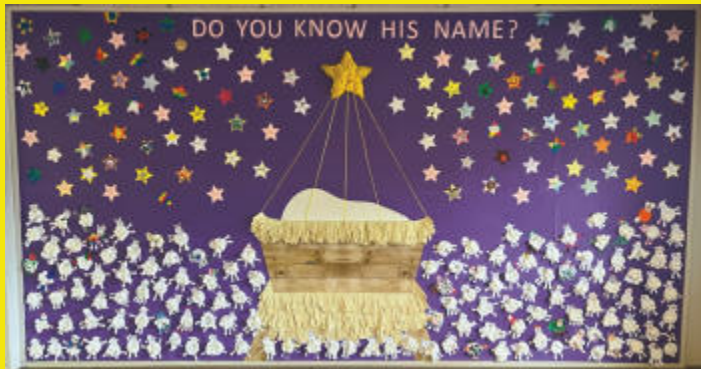

Below are a few suggestions for us from FORMED.ORG to get us started. This on-demand website is free to all parishioners, and has extensive video, audio and reading selections.

You may want to consider the following:

For young children, under 10: *Adventure Catechism*, each 20 min segment in a cartoon format introduces children to one aspect of the Catholic faith.

For teens and adults: *Journey Through Advent with Bishop Robert Baron*, a series of homilies by Bishop Baron on the Cycle C scripture readings in Advent.

All parishioners at St. Mary's have access to the FORMED.ORG website; all of the content is free of charge to St. Mary's parishioners. To access videos, click ON DEMAND, then use the WATCH heading to find and stream these and other videos. You can also use the SEARCH function on the website to find specific videos, as well as audio tapes and books.

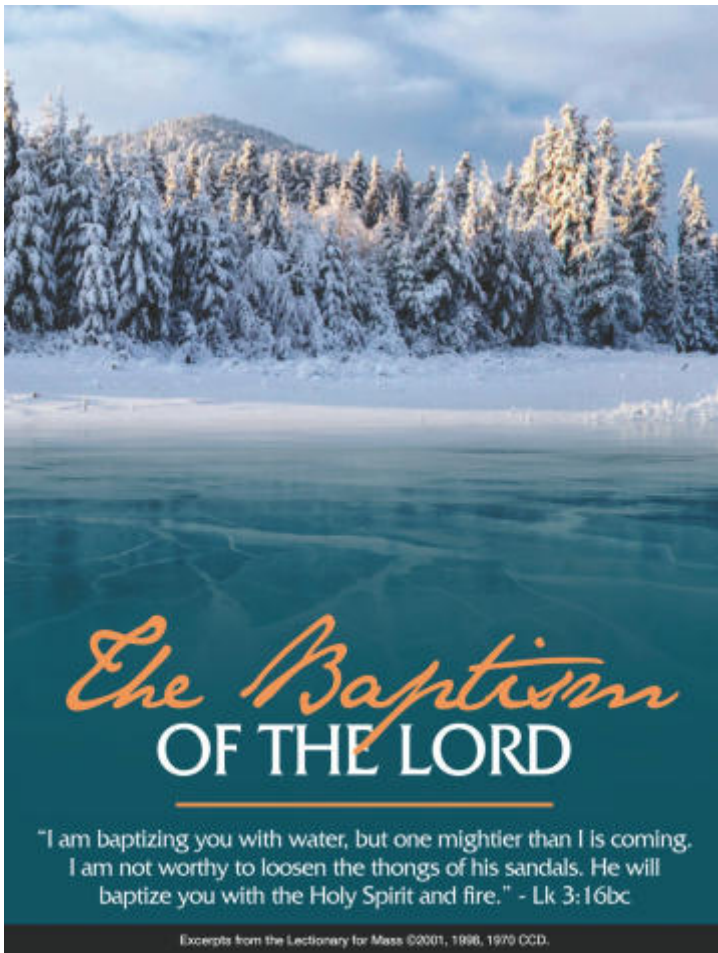
