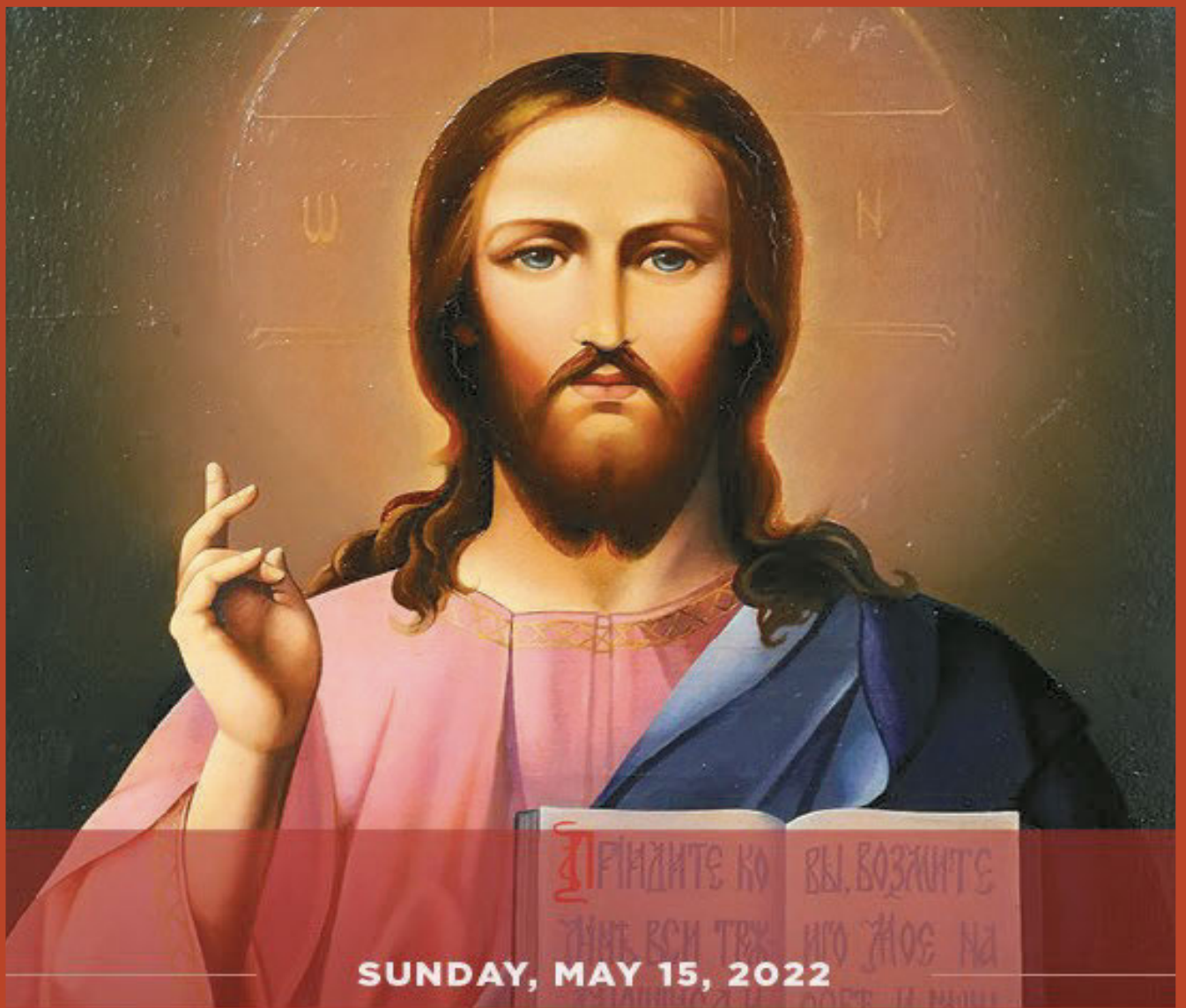

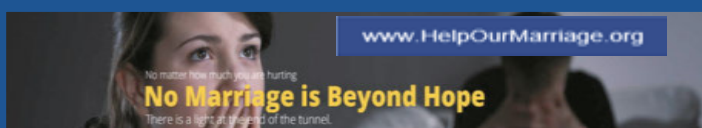



Accountability

RESPONSE TO ALLEGATIONS

- 
Reporting
 All allegations of sexual abuse of a minor by Church personnel are reported to the NH Attorney General's Office; if the allegation involves a current minor, reports are made to the NH Division for Children, Youth & Families and the local police.
- 
Investigation
 Allegations are investigated by professionals in a timely fashion.
- 
Review
 The Diocesan Review Board reviews investigative results and offers advice to the Bishop.
- 
Compassionate Assistance
 The Office for Healing and Pastoral Care offers pastoral support to victims and their families, including counseling referrals and spiritual care.
- 
Financial Compensation
 The Diocese has developed a non-confrontational process for victims to seek financial compensation, regardless of when the abuse occurred.
- 
Confidentiality
 While the diocese maintains strict confidentiality, those who receive financial settlements for sexual abuse as a minor are not required to sign confidentiality agreements.

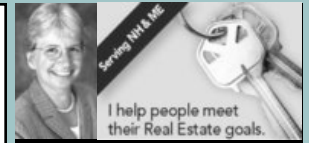
