Dear Parishioners,

Since the mystery of Easter cannot really be put into words unless they are sung, let's consider some very recent offerings with their key lines: From "Give Thanks" by Don Moen: "And now, let the weak say I am strong, let the poor say I am rich, because of what the Lord has done!"

From "Christ is Risen from the Dead" by Matt Maher: "Christ has risen from the dead, trampling over death by death, come awake, come awake, come and rise up from the dead!"

From "The Easter Song" by The Second Chapter of Acts: "Hear the bells ringing, they're singing, Christ is risen from the dead! Hear the bells ringing, they're singing you can be born again!" The angel, upon the tombstone says, "He is risen just as he said. Go quickly, tell his disciples that Jesus Christ is no longer dead! Joy to the world, he is risen!"

From "Still Rolls the Stone," by Bob Bennett: "I tore off my grave clothes, and cried a pool of tears, for the voice of the Living One, Who spoke the stars and spheres, has called me from my darkness, and led me to this place, where the dead leap, and the blind see his face. 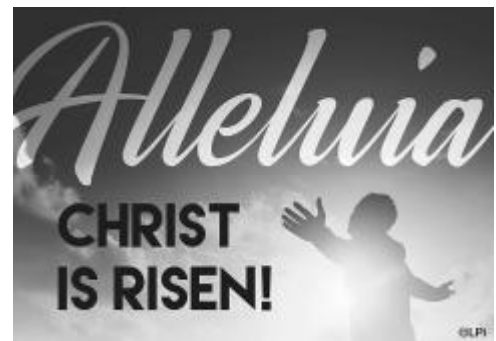
