Holy Trinity Choir will resume rehearsals on **Thursday, January 20th @ 5:00 pm**. Rehearsals will be held weekly, **every Thursday @ 5:00 pm**.

In the last days of 2021, Bishop Lucia announced a realignment of the regions of the Diocese, creating new regions. Also, he announced new Vicars for those regions, including our own. He has chosen to use terms more consistent with Canon Law giving the Vicars special tasks. In the late 1970s when the regions were first created and assigned Vicars, rather than Deans, the Vicars were Episcopal Vicars, meaning they were delegated with powers that were previously reserved to the Bishop. Bishop Moynihan changed that, so their responsibilities were more reserved to the responsibilities of the region, and the term for that is Vicar Forane (for-ane, a priest who by a bishop's appointment exercises limited jurisdiction over the clergy in a district of a diocese). **The Vicar Forane for Region VII Southern Chenango and Broome Counties is Rev. James Serowik of Bl. Sacrament/St. Vincent De Paul, Vestal, New York.**

A special thank you goes to Msgr. John P. Putano for his past service as Regional Vicar.

These new regions may lead for further re-configuration of a few PCAs, but even more it is the Bishop's sincere hope that these designations will assist and re-affirm PCAs in their need to work together ever more closely.

On Our Knees Prayer & Fasting Campaign

On January 22nd each year, the Catholic Church in the United States observes a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children to mark the Supreme Court Decision, Roe v. Wade on 1/22/73 that legalized abortion throughout the United States.

Please join the On Our Knees campaign in prayer and fasting for the Dobbs Supreme Court Case (a Mississippi Case that may overturn Roe v. Wade; a decision is expected on 6/22/22 from the Supreme Court) beginning January 22 - June 22, 2022.

Fasting: Limit yourself to one or two smaller meals on the 22nd of each month or fast from social media, videos, music or something else you like.

Prayer: Holy Trinity, Source of Life and Truth we entrust our nation to You. We ask for mercy for the decades of legalized abortion that has been permitted in our land. We ask that the sacredness of every human life would be protected and upheld both in law and in culture. In a special way we commend to you the Justices of the Supreme Court. Please grant them clarity, wisdom and courage to judge according to truth and right reason. Overthrow, at last, by Your power, the scourge of abortion in our land and usher in a new era of protection for the unborn. By the power of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection, may Your perfect justice be established on earth. Amen.

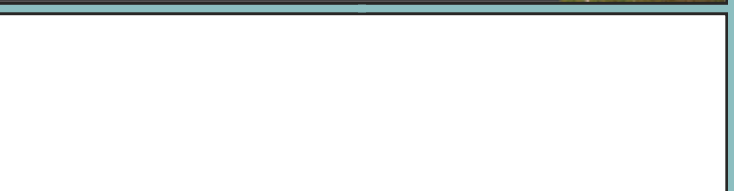

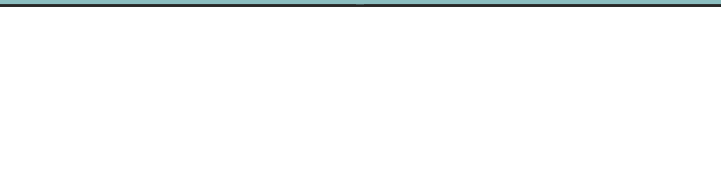
