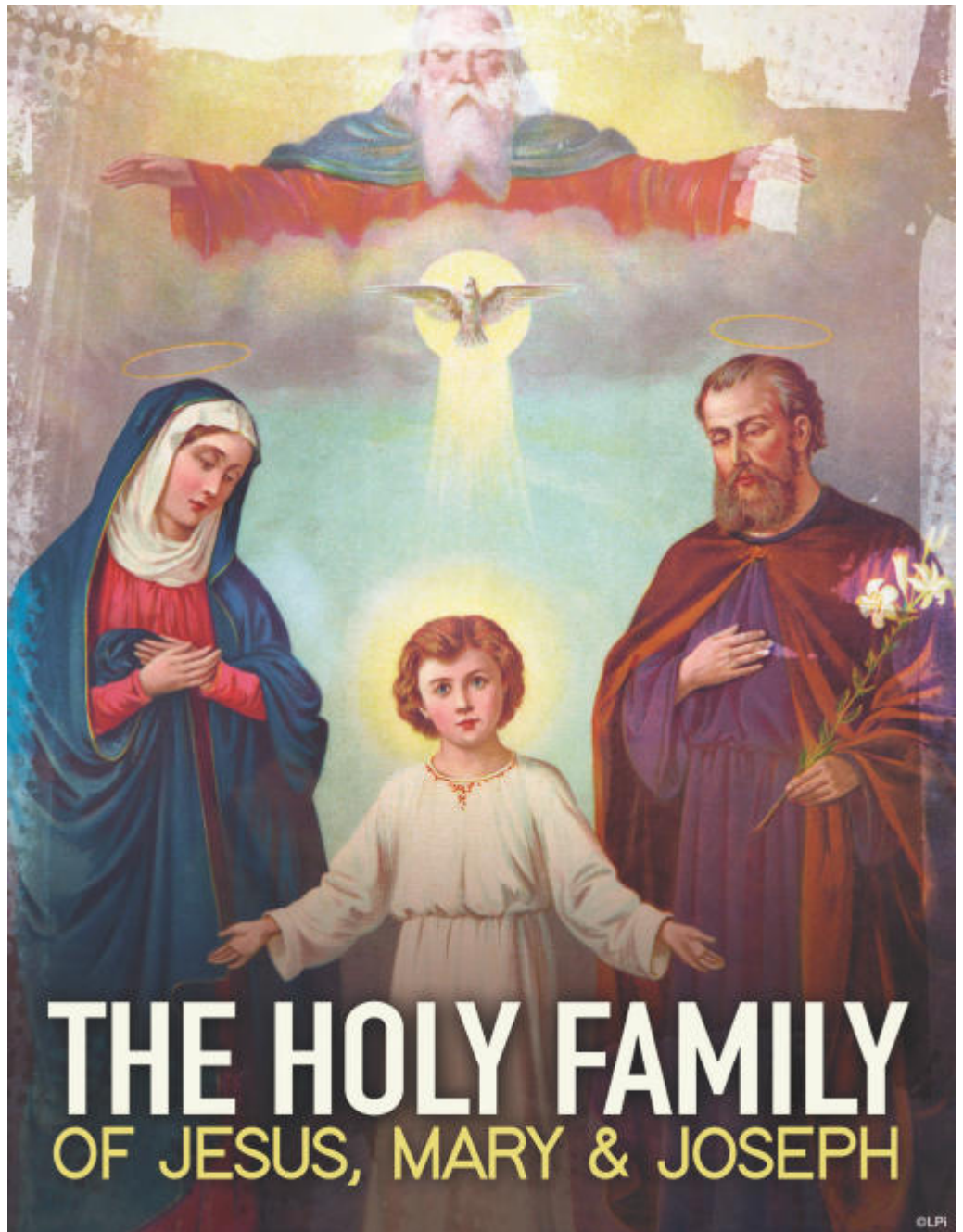

FROM FATHER'S DESK

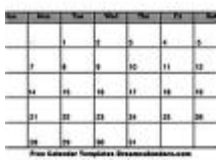
