AID a Pet update - & Where You Come In!

Nilsa is one of AID a Pet's most hard working and diligent volunteers. She manages the Pet Pantry at the Church and makes sure that all the pet food and supplies are well stored. Nilsa also handles the distribution days where we serve more than 50 people and their animals.



Recently Nilsa has fallen upon hard times in her personal life. She may have to move from her current home and she is hampered in moving by her pets. Although she dearly loves them she realized that they would be better off in other caring homes. Specifically, Nilsa has two young dogs .. Tank (M) and Tinkerbelle (F) who she cannot keep. They came from the same litter and are just over a year old. These two small dogs (no more than 30 lbs) are a mix of Shih Tzu and Bull Terrier which actually results in an adorable combination. Both dogs are spayed/neutered, healthy and well socialized.
