Saint Joseph along with Our Lord and the Blessed Mother is one of our parish patrons. The poet, in a surprising way, points out his practical side: a crib for Jesus. The Epiphany of the Lord

"Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." (Matt. 2:2)

The 12 days of Christmas end with the Epiphany of the Lord, which is traditionally celebrated on January 6. In the United States, the Epiphany is celebrated on the closest Sunday to the sixth, so this year that is today, Sunday, January 2.

- The word Epiphany means "manifestation" or "showing forth."
- An Epiphany is an event or action that makes something clear or evident.
- Today we celebrate The Three Kings (Wiseman or Magi) following the Star to Bethlehem, to the stable where Jesus was born.
- The names of the three kings are: Balthasar, Melchior, and Caspar.
- They brought gifts to Baby Jesus of Gold because Jesus is king; Frankincense because Jesus is God; and Myrrh because Jesus would one day die upon the cross to save us from our sins.

The Epiphany should remind us of how special Jesus is and that we should spend our lives seeking Him. Jesus is the light for everyone and if we follow Him, we will never go astray.
