# The Second Sunday of Easter

In today's Gospel (John 20:19-31):

- Jesus greets His disciples with the gift of peace.
- Jesus then commissions His disciples to continue the work that He has begun; as Jesus was sent by God, so Jesus sends His disciples out to spread the Good News.
- He gives His disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit so that they will be able to do the work He is sending them out to do.

"Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

The story of Thomas illustrates our faith experience today: **We are called to believe without seeing.** In fact, all Christians, after the first witnesses, have been called to believe in Jesus without seeing. Thomas's doubt is hardly surprising; the news of Jesus' appearance was incredible to the disciples who had seen him crucified and buried. Because Thomas was human, he wanted real evidence that the Jesus who appeared to the disciples after his death was indeed the same Jesus who had been crucified. (Imagine how hard it would be to know that you saw someone die and yet now, he or she is standing, alive, with you.)

Thomas could easily represent you or me. As humans, we often need proof that something is real or true. We want evidence that the Jesus who appeared to his disciples after his death is the same Jesus who was crucified. Thomas is given the opportunity to be our representative in obtaining this evidence... "Then He said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

# Divine Mercy Sunday – April 24

In the Jubilee Year 2000, Pope John Paul II proclaimed that from that year forward the Second Sunday of Easter would be celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday. This was proclaimed at the Canonization Mass of St. Faustina Kawalska, who worked throughout her life to make all aware of the merciful love of God.



Pope John Paul II said, "... It is a message that is clear and understandable for everyone. Anyone can come here (to St. Faustina's tomb in Lagiewniki, Poland), look at this image of the merciful Jesus, His Heart radiating grace, and hear in the depths of his own soul what Blessed Faustina heard: "Fear nothing. I am with you always." "And if this person responds with a sincere heart: "Jesus, I trust in You," they will find comfort in all anxieties and fears...."

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
