

THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FAMILY NOTES, XIII Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 26, 2022

Dear friends, peace!

Allow me to offer you some thoughts still with me from last week's Feast of the Body of Christ. "We proclaim Christ <u>crucified</u>...", writes Saint Paul in I Corinthians 1:23. And explaining the Eucharist in Chapter 11:26 he teaches, "As often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the <u>death</u> of the Lord until he comes again."

Twice at the Last Supper Our Lord insisted that we "remember " His Passion and Death for us. Our mystics have helped to contemplate the meaning and power of His terrible suffering. Recently in The Pilot of May 6, 2022, Michael Pakaluk shared how deeply he was affected by his reading of the insights of Saint Alphonsus Liguori and other saints about the Passion.

THE SCOURGING

For example, concerning the scourging: "...Liguori corroborates its devastating brutality. The scourging was so severe, he says, that one could see Our Lord's ribs. Flesh was hanging down in one of his arms. And, but for an exercise of divine power, Our Lord would have expired. He deliberately strengthened himself, Liguori remarks, so that he could suffer more." Mr. Pakaluk offers Saint Ambrose's shocking detail that "Our Lord had to be put into his own garments again, simply so that the people could even recognize him—so severely had he been disfigured. His whole body was as if a single bleeding wound...."

THE CROWNING

"Again, the thorns were really a helmet more than a crown, and it extended down to the middle of Our Lord's forehead. You no doubt know how profusely the scalp bleeds. His face was a mass of blood, as was his body. His blood was truly "poured out" for us.... The pain in his hands and feet was excruciating!"

DESOLATION

And then there was His terrible inner struggle. "Our Lord lacked even the slightest alleviation or consolation, even from the Father." (Thus His cry using the words of Psalm 22: 1, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken me?") Finally Mr. Pakaluk looks at Mary.

MARY'S PAIN

He cites Saint Bernard and writes, "Remarkably, neither did Mary's presence comfort him: her pain only added to his affliction." Adding Bernard's words, "The Mother being filled with pain, the ocean of her sorrow poured itself back upon the Son." Woe! And all of this and much, much more was endured for one fundamental reason. Love! Paul writes, "....the Son of God has loved me and given himself up for me." (Galatians 2:20).

SURRENDER

Let's go back to the Mass. The Sacred Host is really our Sacred Lord. He comes among us at the Consecration. Then He gives His entire self to us at Communion. Speaking for myself, I have to keep working at letting go of that "corner of my heart" St. Anthony preached when he said: "Don't keep a corner of your heart for yourself. He bought the whole of you by giving His whole self for you that He might possess every part of you. Give it all to Him. He will give you all of Himself....thus....you will have Him and yourself besides." (Magnificat, June, 2022, p.192). Truth to tell, I keep a lot more than a "corner" for myself! Maybe you are like me? How odd. I'm cheap with Jesus! How stupid. He has never held anything back, has he? Let us both determine that we will surrender all we are to Him who gave His all for us. Praised be Jesus!


