



Baptism

This is the first Sacrament of Christian Initiation, and was instituted by Christ Himself, when he was baptized by John the Baptist. Baptism imprints an indelible character on the baptized person's soul.

Baptism is the gateway or door to life in the Holy Spirit. The water of baptism signifies our birth into the Divine Life of the Holy Spirit. Just as the Spirit descended upon Jesus on this Feast and the voice of the Spirit stated, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." The Holy Spirit descended upon us even without a voice at our baptism; and thus we are instruments both of the Creator, Savior and Sanctifier. May the Trinity bless us in this New Year to use well the gifts of Creation, Forgiveness and Peace.

SAVE THE DATE

Sunday, March 13th at 5 pm in the church. The theme this year will be AFRAID: The Gospel of Mark—All High school students and their

parents are required to attend. There is no charge for this and it is a time of quite reflection and prayer. He is a Hollywood Catholic actor who has been here numerous times and is well acknowledged and appreciated. He intends to come unless there is a major COVID uprising near this date.

⇒ COVID — with this disease still present I think it is only right for the health and safety of all that we continue to WEAR A MASK until probably March 1st. I fully understand those who have been vaccinated may not want to continue, that is your choice; but those who have not been vaccinated, should, for others, wear a mask. We want to hold to the Gospel value, LOVE ONE ANOTHER. So for the care of others, I think we should be wearing a mask. There will be no Holy Water, Missalettes or music until March 1st. You should socialize outside of church for the comfort of all. Communion will continue to be a double line starting from the rear pews so all may social distance. I am pleased that many have returned to mass but some are still frightened and we want to get them back to the Eucharist by trying to keep our mass schedule at 30 minutes or less. Try to come on time. Thank you all who have returned and are wearing masks. We will be having string instrumentals during Christmas time.

Afghan Refugees — the parish will plan to assist a family with \$2,000 a month, a \$1,000 for rent and a \$1,000 for food. Start saving your money and using the extra envelopes in the back of your box or a plain white envelope and drop it in the basket, stating "For Afghan Refugees"

UPDATE: We are working with the Church of Christ Congregational in Goshen to raise the base funds to support an Afghan family in this area. They are determining a location for the family and our Parish will be supporting them with food and rent expenses.






