

Sunday, March 13th at 5 pm in the church. The theme this year will be AFRAID: The Gospel of Mark—All High school students

and their parents are required to attend. There is no charge for this and it is a time of quite reflection and prayer. He is a Hollywood Catholic actor who has been here numerous times and is well acknowledged and appreciated.
