

The Most Holy Trinity is the chief mystery of our faith and the reason behind

our always beginning and ending prayer with the Sign of the Cross. In adoring the Holy Trinity, Life Giving, Consubstantial, and indivisible the church's faith also processes the distinction between each person..., Father, Son and Holy Spirit. When the Father sends His Word, He always sends His breath. In their joint mission, the Son and the Holy Spirit are distinct but inseparable. Our challenge is both to appreciate the gifts of creation, the imitation of Christ and the gifts of the Spirit as our way of living what we say we believe in making the Sign of the Cross. REFLECT on your making this Sign, and see that it is done indeed with reverence and respect and not just do it.


