St. Benedict and St. Bonaventure

St. Benedict's Feast is July 11th and St. Bonaventure's is July 15th. St. Benedict is the Patriarch of Western Monasticism, as he saw corruption in the world and began a life as a hermit of Penance and Prayer. His reputation for prayer, work and sanctity gathered disciples and in 529 AD, he began the great Monastery of Monte Cassino. His Rule is the basis for religious life. His great teaching was, *"never prefer anything to love."*

St. Bonaventure called the Seraphic Doctor, entered the Franciscans, and was a noted scholar, doctor and bishop of the church. At the age of 35, he was chosen General of the Franciscans and returned the order to the example given by St. Francis. He died in 1274 and it was his desire that a burning charity for others would inspire all to follow Christ.




