



## Pastor's Column

Thanks go out once again to the **Fun(d) Committee** who paid for the repairs to the boiler room door in the church. The cost was \$559.34.

If you missed the Lenten Fish Dinner on March 11 or 25 you missed a good meal of baked haddock or fried shrimp with two sides. Don't despair. You have another opportunity coming up on April 8 from 5-7 p.m. in the social hall. Thanks to the **Knights of Columbus** Councils 871 and 16069 for sponsoring these dinners.

**Hanover Rural King** store at 1155 Carlisle St. recently sent us a "thank you" letter and a check for \$100.00 for our participation in "Church Week 2021." The letter to us stated, "It is a privilege to partner with you in giving back to the communities you serve. We know it is because of your dedicated patrons, who took the time to register and make a purchase that this support is given to you and your mission. Again, thank you for letting us partner with you and we pray this donation will bless your organization."

Thanks also to the parishioner who for years has paid for the **Paschal Candle**. This new candle is first blessed in a detailed rite and then lit in darkness from a blessed fire in the brazier in the St. Joseph Church courtyard at the beginning of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday evening. In procession it is brought into the church by one of our deacons. During the Easter Season it will have a prominent position in the sanctuary. From then on the Paschal Candle is utilized in the celebration of baptisms, from which the smaller baptismal candles are lit and given to the newly baptized or their parents. This large candle is also prominent in the sanctuary for the celebration of Funeral Masses and Services.

The Paschal Candle has a long history and is one of the most sacred and enduring elements in all of Christianity. It represents Christ and the ritual of blessing it is filled with symbolism. The priest cuts a cross into the candle with a stylus. Then he makes the Greek letter Alpha above the cross, the letter Omega below, and the four numerals of the current year while saying the following eight statements with each cut into the candle: "Christ yesterday and today/ the Beginning and the End/ the Alpha/ and the Omega/ All time belongs to him/ and all the ages/ To him be glory and power/ through every age and forever. Amen. The priest then inserts five grains of incense into the candle in the form of a cross saying the following five statements, one for each of the grains of incense: By his holy/ and glorious wounds/ may Christ the Lord/ guard us/ and protect us. Amen. The Easter Vigil begins at 8:00 p.m. on Holy Saturday, April 16, 2022.


