

## Pastor's Column

Tomorrow evening, Monday, May 2, Delone Catholic High School holds its annual **Academic Banquet** honoring students who have excelled in academics, ranking in the top 10% of their class. They are: from the class of 2023; Aden Davis, Rebecca Lazo, and Gracie Wildasin; from the class of 2024 Matthew Leon Abanto and Riley Slee. Congratulations to these scholars for their hard work and dedication to their studies.

Every year we send 75% of our Ash Wednesday collection to the Hanover Area Council of Churches, which this year amounted to **\$4,759.61**. 25% of the total collection, \$1,586.54, went to our St. Vincent de Paul account which also helps those in need. Thank you to everyone who contributed financially and prayerfully.

The **Knights of Columbus** did a great job on the Lenten Fish Dinners, which were well attended. The two councils, 871 and 16069, that sponsored these Friday dinners had a profit of \$1,645.65, of which they donated \$548.55 to our parish. Thank you guys for all the work you did. Additional generosity to the parish came from the **Grandview Seniors** who gave us \$500.00 for tuition assistance to help families send their children to our Catholic School. If you see Carol Gerkin of our parish tell her thanks for helping to make this donation possible.

The suffering of the **Ukrainian people** unfortunately continues. The amount collected here in the parish was \$6,695.94. However, that does not include donations sent to the Diocese of Harrisburg or directly to the Ukrainian Eparchy here in the United States, both of which would get the money to those in need. Thank you for the donations and for your continued prayers.

Next Sunday we celebrate **Mother's Day**. Now is the time to send your card to mom. On behalf of the staff of St. Joseph Parish I wish all the moms in our parish a very Happy Mother's Day. May it be a special day for you where your children let you prop up your feet and even take a nap; where your husband cooks you a meal that is actually edible and then totally cleans up the kitchen after himself, and is there to catch you when you faint in surprise and wonder.

Although Mother's Day is a secular and not a religious holiday it provides an opportunity for us to give thanks to our mothers for all they have done for us, the big and the small sacrifices, and especially the ones of which we knew nothing. It is a day for us to express our appreciation and to offer our prayers for that one special person who has given us life.






