

Pastor's Column

Beginning today, Sunday, May 8, we celebrate our parish **Forty Hours Eucharistic Devotions** with a service at 7:00 p.m. today, Monday, and Tuesday. Fr. Philip Burger, former Parochial Vicar here at Saint Joseph Parish and now Pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Abbottstown, is our homilist. Please join us for these three evenings and also sign up for a time period of private devotion in the church during the day. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament begins on Sunday at approximately 3:00 p.m. and continues through the service at 7:00 p.m. On Monday and Tuesday exposition begins at approximately 9:30 a.m. following the 9:00 a.m. Mass, and continues through the service at 7:00 p.m.

Last week I highlighted five students from our parish who were honored at the Delone Catholic Academic Banquet for being in the top 10% of their class. This week I get to draw your attention to the academic excellence in the study of the Catholic Faith by Timothy Martz, one of our home schooled parishioners. On Tuesday, April 26, at the Diocesan Center in Harrisburg **Tim took First Place in the Diocesan Faith Bee**. (Tim had previously won here in our parish.) He was with 20 other 7th and 8th grade students from all over the diocese who were given over 400 questions and answers to study to prepare for the oral portion. In the written portion they had to list the Old Testament books in order, New Testament books in order, Ecumenical Councils in order, choirs of angels, the most recent 10 popes in order, and all the bishops of Harrisburg in order. The last five students answered all of the written and oral questions correctly, so the examiners pulled questions out of the air that students had not been given ahead of time to study. It lasted for 4 hours from 2:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. until Tim won by knowing that Jacob's hip was injured by wrestling with God. A big congratulations to you Tim and to your parents for faithfully and accurately handing on the Catholic Faith to you.

Not only are our students academically sound but they've got talent. This Wednesday, May 11, at 9:45 a.m., in the parish social hall our **school talent show** will be presented live on stage. Because of COVID we have not been able to do this live since 2019. All are welcome! You will love it, and the students will be pleased they can perform for you.

Thank you **Fun(d) committee** members and parishioners who supported them in their Easter Candy and Bake Sale on April 9-10. The net profit was \$2,437.84.

Today we celebrate Mothers' Day, which was highlighted in my pastor's column in last week's bulletin. We honor mothers for their sacrificial love in providing for their children. It is also a day for us to remember our spiritual mother, Mary. We **honor Mary as the Mother of Christ and the Mother of the Church**. By her charity she has joined in bringing about the birth of believers in the Church. Mary aided the beginnings of the Church by her prayers and continues to pray for the Church today. We correctly honor Mary since Holy Scripture, referring to Mary, tells us "All generations will call me blessed." On this Mother's Day, we also remember our spiritual mother and say, "Hail Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope."

This annual retreat on the beautiful campus of Mount Saint Mary's University has proven to be a very rewarding and faith enriching activity for the thousands and thousands of men who have attended over the years. 


