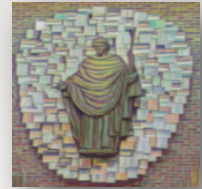

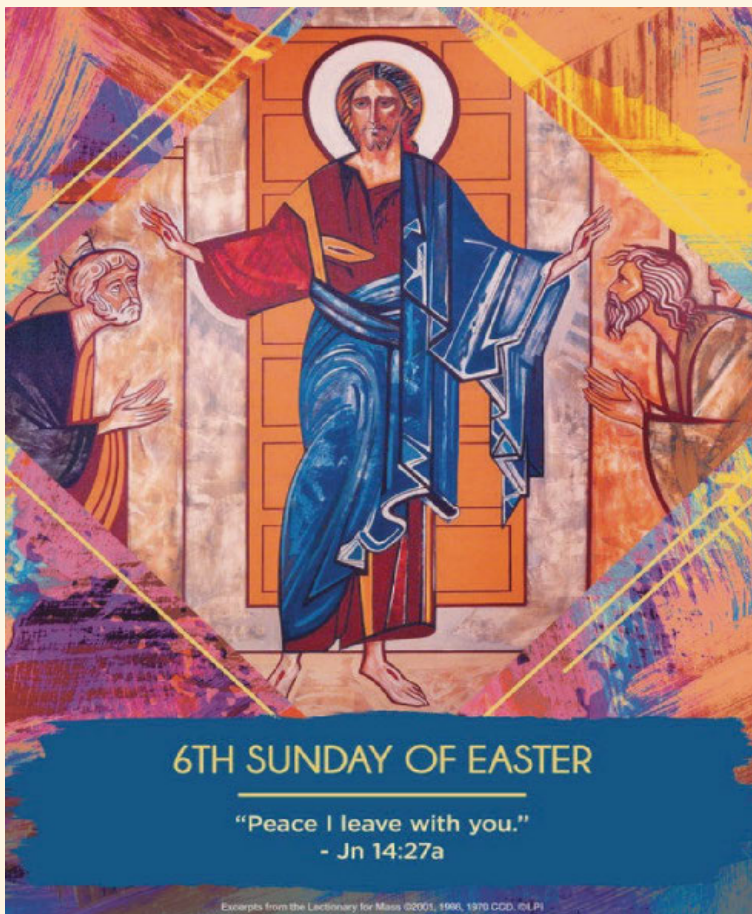

Writing this column on Sunday, May 15, I plan to concelebrate the **Funeral Mass for Mrs. Susan M. Mummert** on Thursday, May 19, at her home parish of Saint Rose of Lima, York, PA. She had an extensive background in Catholic education and was the Principal here at St. Joseph Parish School for 20 years from 1996 to 2016. As the obituary says of Mrs. Mummert, "As Principal of St. Joseph [School] Hanover, she leaves a legacy of always placing the 'children first,' calling on them to live their faith, to strive for excellence and to care for one another." Speaking of Catholic education, the **Delone Catholic High School Baccalaureate** was celebrated here at St. Joseph Church on Thursday, May 19, at 5:30 p.m. Father Dan Mitzel, Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Parish, Gettysburg, was the celebrant with 11 concelebrating priests. Father Sam Miller preached the homily which is always reserved for the chaplain of Delone Catholic. Eighty-seven seniors were present along with faculty, staff, families, and friends. The graduation ceremony was held on Friday, May 20. We wish them a faith filled life striving for excellence and loving one another as Christ has loved us.

The **8th grade graduation and Mass** occurs this coming week on Tuesday, May 24, at 6:30 p.m. in our church. Twelve students will graduate and receive awards and recognition for their efforts in various subjects and activities, but also in living their Catholic faith. I thank the parents of these students who are the first teachers of their children. A Catholic school is meant to complement and extend what parents teach their children in the home, and especially in the realm of moral behavior in accordance with the Catholic Church. I thank the Principal, Mr. Staub, the faculty, and staff of our school for their untiring efforts in offering a faith-filled academic and moral education.

Continuing to speak about Catholic Education, we have funds dedicated to helping families obtain a Catholic Education for their children. **Scholarships** are available and applications need to be made early in the academic year for the next academic year. **Tuition assistance** is also available and comes directly from our school through the generosity of our parishioners. Volunteers Needed

The Diocesan Summer Camp for Adults with Developmental Disabilities is seeking volunteers to assist at its residential camp, August 14-19, 2022. There is a critical need this year for a **camp nurse or doctor** to provide health oversight. A stipend will be offered. Held at Camp Kirchenwald in Lebanon County, the camp is dependent on volunteers and has been run annually for the past 36 years. Over these years, volunteers from parishes throughout our Diocese have participated alongside volunteers from other faith communities to make this ministry a success. Interested persons 16+ are welcome to volunteer for full-time or part-time duties. There are no special qualifications or minimum time required for volunteering, but there is a particular need for volunteers who are able to spend the night. All volunteers are required to complete the Diocesan Clearance process and to provide proof of vaccination from the COVID-19 virus (vaccination waivers may be granted). Attendance at a brief training session prior to helping at camp is also required. There is no cost to volunteers; all meals, events, campground activities, etc. are included. Deadline for expressing volunteer interest is July 1st.

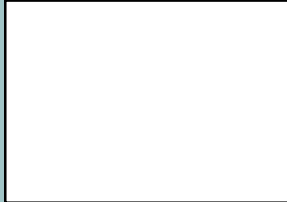

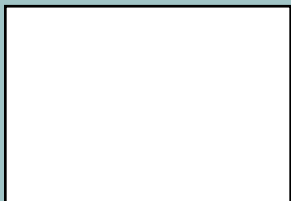
