



As the obituary says of Mrs. Mummert, "As Principal of St. Joseph [School] Hanover, she leaves a legacy of always placing the 'children first,' calling on them to live their faith, to strive for excellence and to care for one another." Speaking of Catholic education, the **Delone Catholic High School Baccalaureate** was celebrated here at St. Joseph Church on Thursday, May 19, at 5:30 p.m. Father Dan Mitzel, Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Parish, Gettysburg, was the celebrant with 11 concelebrating priests. Father Sam Miller preached the homily which is always reserved for the chaplain of Delone Catholic. Eighty-seven seniors were present along with faculty, staff, families, and friends. 




