

**2021 PARISH FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

The St. Mary Parish Finance Committee presents the 2021 Parish Financial Statement for period ending June 30, 2021. First, we would like to thank the parishioners for your continued support of the parish through weekly collections and the annual collection during these unprecedented times.

Additionally, you may have seen work being done around the parish campus. Three projects are currently underway. The first, and largest, is the church entrance floor. This is the final portion of the project that was started several years ago. We look forward to the completion of this project very soon. The second will be replacement of the 54 windows and exterior doors of the rectory. The rectory is our oldest building on the campus and is in need of several improvements, which the window project is one. The new energy efficient windows will also help save us heating expenses over the long term. The last was a new floor in the hall's kitchen. This is the final piece of the kitchen renovation project that many of the parish's groups have partnered with the parish to make over the last several years.

The Finance Committee has prepared a display for each of these projects which will be located in the rear of the church. We encourage parishioners to take a moment to look at these. They will help explain more about each project and why these projects needed to be done. We are working to fund these projects without a separate donation campaign. We hope that you consider a contribution or increased donation to the 2021 parish collection to help fund these and future projects around the campus.
