

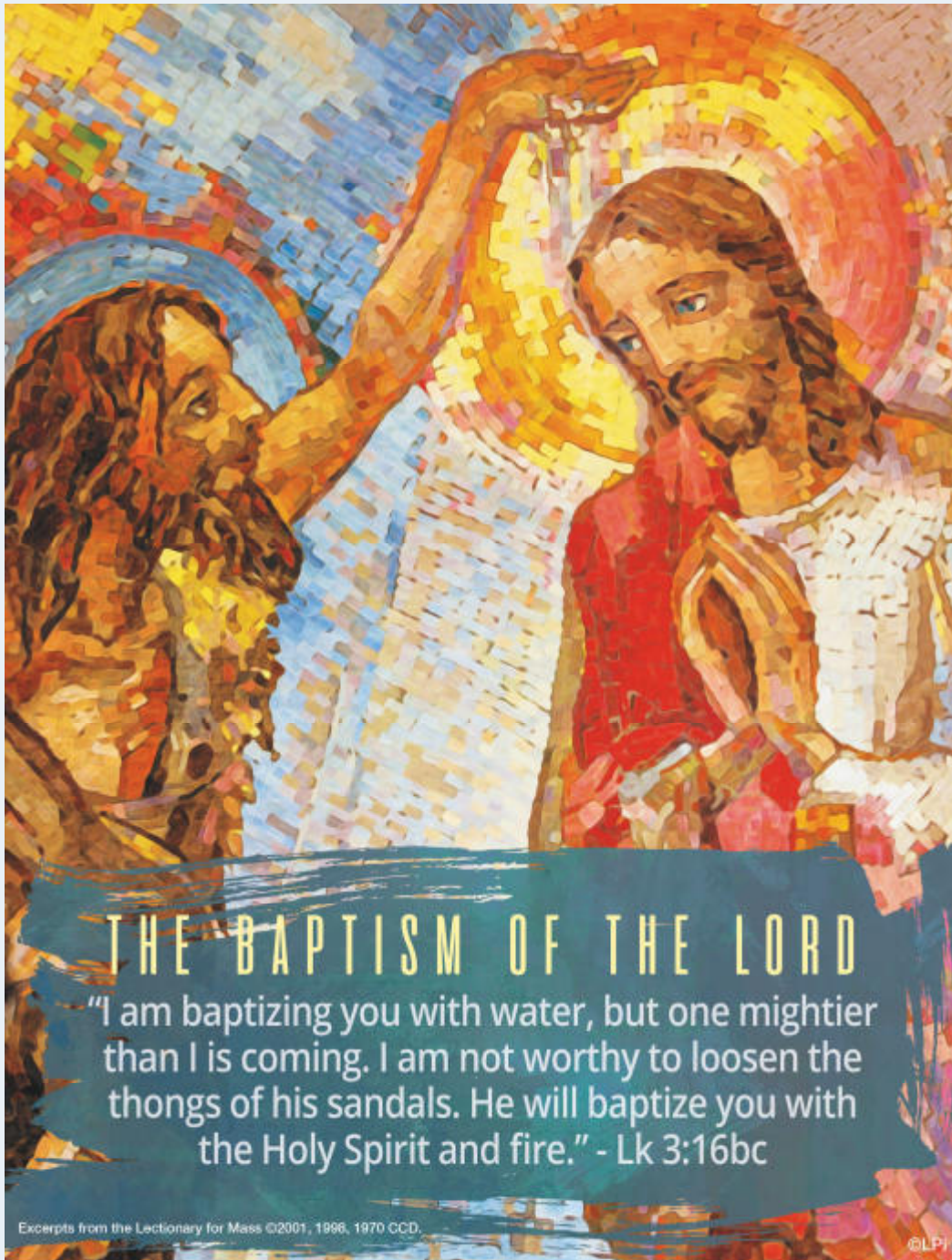

### SACRAMENTS

**Reconciliation** Saturday 2:30 to 3:30 PM, and by appointment.

**Baptism** Baptisms are scheduled the first and third Sunday of each month. Pre-sacramental instruction is required. Please contact the parish office at 508-432-4000 to make arrangements.

**First Eucharist** Two-year preparation required for children. Must be at second grade level or beyond to receive.

**Confirmation** Two-year preparation required for young people. Must be at least at 9th grade level to receive. Other arrangements available for adults.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** Please contact the parish office at 508-432-4000.

**Marriage** Couples planning to enter marriage should contact the rectory no less than six months in advance of the wedding, and no more than one year.

**Anointing of the Sick** Communal and individual celebrations of this sacrament of healing are available to those struggling with serious or chronic illness or infirmity. Parishioners preparing for surgery may request the Sacrament of Anointing prior to admission to the hospital.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick and Homebound** Communion visits to ill or infirm parishioners at home or in skilled nursing facilities may be arranged by calling Joan Ryan at 508-432-3710.

He is inviting Catholics around the world to enter into “Synodality,” a process of listening to one another in all facets of Church life as envisioned by the Second Vatican Council to strengthen our Church so that it will continue to serve for generations to come.

To that end, Bishop da Cunha has appointed Ambassadors in each parish of the Fall River Diocese to guide the process. The Ambassadors for Holy Trinity are Joan Ryan and Brian Kennedy, and we are grateful for their willingness to help.

We also owe special thanks to Tony Cosgrove, who – though he knew he would be unable to continue in the role of Ambassador because he is away during the winter – attended the Diocesan introductory meeting in November. Tony provided us with many insights into the process and we appreciate his service.

The two Ambassadors are in the process of assembling a team of parishioners who will be facilitators of the meetings that will be scheduled soon and which will be announced in subsequent bulletins.

Let us pray for the success of the Synodal process—that it will increase our faith and that it will help people who have drifted away from the Church to take a second look. ~ Fr. Marc

## EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### I Hope I Am Like Him

“Who is this Christ? Is he like you?”

Perhaps you’ve heard this story, often attributed to the life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. A sick man asked her this question, as he marveled at her tireless service to himself and others in the name of someone named Jesus Christ.

“He is nothing like me,” the saint is said to have answered. “But I hope I am like him.”

Though the authenticity of this exchange cannot be verified, its message rings perfectly true: all the value of our stewardship lies in its relativity to the one in whose name we perform it.

Consider the figure of John the Baptist—a magnificent, towering character even purely from a literary or historical perspective. A martyr who fed on wild locusts and boldly spoke truth to power—a man so great some mistook him for the Messiah.

But why is he great? Because he prepared the way. All his accomplishments and escapades mean nothing if they are taken out of the context of salvation history. He only makes sense relative to Christ—and this is exactly as he wanted it. “One worthier than I is coming,” he insists. And because of that humility and that total embrace of God’s will, he is given one of the greatest honors in the New Testament—he baptizes the Son of God.

Let’s examine our lives in the light of their relativity to Christ. How do we prepare the way? When Christ comes to us, what do we do? How do we leave ourselves open to be actors in God’s plan?

## The Baptism of the Lord

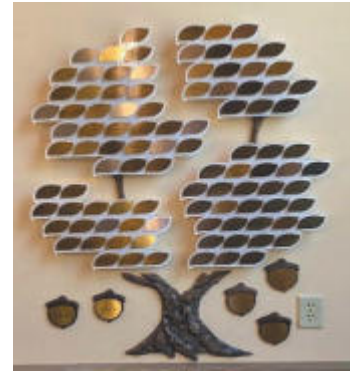
GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY,  
STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

**GROW:** For cradle Catholics, baptism may be the most important step on the Christian journey that none of us actually remembers. Which is too bad! After all, the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* instructs us that baptism is “the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit.” (#1213) Yes, baptism cleanses us of original sin, but it’s much more than that! We need only look to Jesus to see that. Though without sin, Jesus’ baptism is a turning point in his life all the same. The Holy Spirit descends upon him and a voice from heaven cries out, “You are my beloved Son.” So begins the public ministry, in which Jesus would carry out his Father’s saving mission. Through our baptism, at any age, we, too, become God’s beloved sons and daughters. Through word and sacrament, Jesus invites us to share in his mission by turning our lives over to our Father as we embrace our Christian journey.

GO EVANGELIZE | PRAYER  
INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

**GO:** Baptism is often referred to as “the doorway to the Church” because through this sacrament, our sins are forgiven and we are united to Christ and his Church. It is the door which gives access to all the other sacraments. (Cf., CCC 1213) At the conclusion, the celebrant asks God to continue to pour out his blessing upon those being baptized, and send his peace to all who are gathered. As baptized Christians, we are now adopted children of God; we are disciples who are empowered, through the wisdom and strength of the Holy Spirit, to share the Good News and help build the kingdom of God on earth. Sound intimidating? It shouldn’t. Each day that we “put on Christ” and do his work, God is re-creating us and making us into something far better than we could ever be on our own. Embrace this faith you have been given and go out and share your gifts and talents with others, confident in the Spirit that guides you.

**SERVE:** Think of something you have been told you are very good at by friends or coworkers—something for which you have been “anointed,” in a sense. In what way can you do something specific to lead others with care in this area, or perhaps do a very particular good yourself?
