

Why "hybrid"? Because there are several ways to receive or pick up your request tag and then to return your gift card



### **CHANGES AS CHRISTMAS APPROACHES**

The Covid 19 virus has caused everyone to re-think and re-assess every aspect of their social activities. Among these changes are the various ways that have altered our ability to worship together.

Since the re-opening of our beloved church building in May we have steadfastly complied with safe practices such as hand sanitation, social distancing and wearing masks.

In light of the rules limiting personal attendance in the Church itself, we have utilized the Parish Hall to allow parishioners to watch the Mass on a large screen and to have Holy Communion brought to them from one of the Eucharistic Ministers.

Since Christmas is approaching and virus cases continue to rise we feel that now is the best time to describe what Christmas will "look like" at St. Raphael Parish.

As Catholics, our desire to come together to worship and celebrate "Emmanuel" ["God is With Us"] is especially unrelentingly on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

But the Covid-19 virus is unrelenting too and just as there was no "room ... at the inn" for Jesus, Mary and Joseph in Bethlehem [Luke 2:7], the circumstances of this year dictate that there simply will not be sufficient room at the Church to accommodate an overwhelming attendance rush on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

Remember, the dispensation granted by Cardinal Seán from the Sunday Mass obligation remains in effect. Please keep this in mind especially if you are elderly or have a complicating physical/medical condition.

Here are the changes:

**On Christmas Eve, [Thursday, December 24, 2020] there will be Masses at 3:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.** Attendees at these Masses will have the ability - if they choose- to sit in the Parish Hall to view Mass on a large screen. As is our practice, Holy Communion will be brought to them by a Eucharistic Minister.

Please note that there will not be a 4:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve nor will there be a Midnight Mass.

On Christmas Day, [Friday, December 25, 2020] there will be Masses at 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

Each Mass will be shown *"live"* on the Parish Facebook page. In addition the 3:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve will be rebroadcast on Christmas Day on local cable television on Channel 3 [Comcast] and Channel 47 [Verizon] at 8:00 a.m and 11:00 a.m.

Please recall that as Catholics we celebrate "Christmas" on more than a day- it is a liturgical season that begins with the vigil Masses on Christmas Eve and concludes on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 10, 2021. This brings us many opportunities to attend mass to celebrate "Emmanuel" ["God is With Us"].

Sadly, as has been the case since the virus began, there will not be any Choir at any of the masses.

The door to the Church will be open 30 minutes before each mass and we respectfully request that all attendees leave the church promptly and safely after each mass.

Please consider these factors as Christmas approaches and make appropriate decisions to insure the health of your personal families and our parish family as well.

Christmas blessings to the many volunteers who have made worship possible by staying after each Mass or service to disinfect the church. Without their great generosity the doors of our church would be closed.

May the grace and wisdom of the Child born in Bethlehem be upon you and your families this Christmas Season.

# **Advent Beginnings for Families**

Be watchful! Be alert! You do not know when the time will come." (Mark 13:33)

Sometimes Scripture passages can seem distant. Then along came 2020. We're watchful about spreading the virus. We are alert to any cough or fever our kids get. When loved ones are admitted to the hospital, we don't know when the time will come that we might see them again. But let's remember this: God watches too. When we've been shut inside, God has been there. When we watch and wait with loved ones, God watches alongside us. This Advent, let us be watchful of the ways God is here right now, loving us and asking us to trust him.

**Family Prayer**: Light one candle on an Advent wreath. One person can read the prayer aloud while everyone else responds after each line:

We walk in the light of the Lord.\*

- Lord God, we look for you during Advent with hope. \*
- Give us some light each day to find you. \*
- Help us walk in you light, and shine it for others. \*

**Advent Action**: The first Advent candle is called the Prophecy Candle. It symbolizes HOPE. During a meal (or other appropriate time )– talk about times when things felt dark this year, and what gave you hope.


