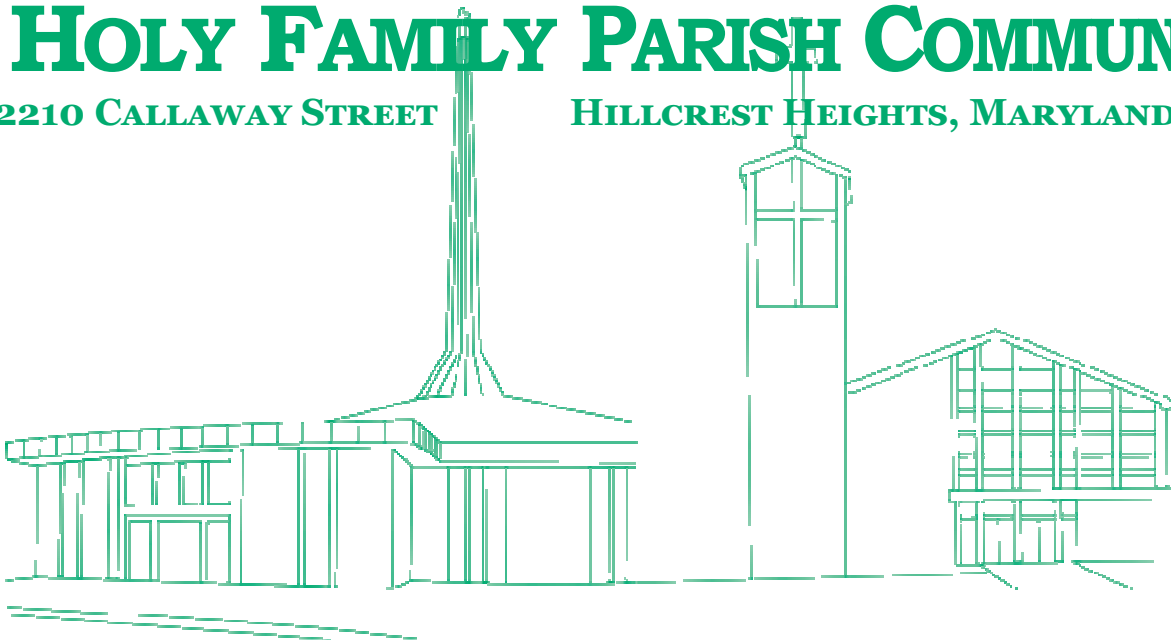

RCIA classes began this Sunday for those interested in finding out about the Catholic faith. Please contact Father Matt for more information.

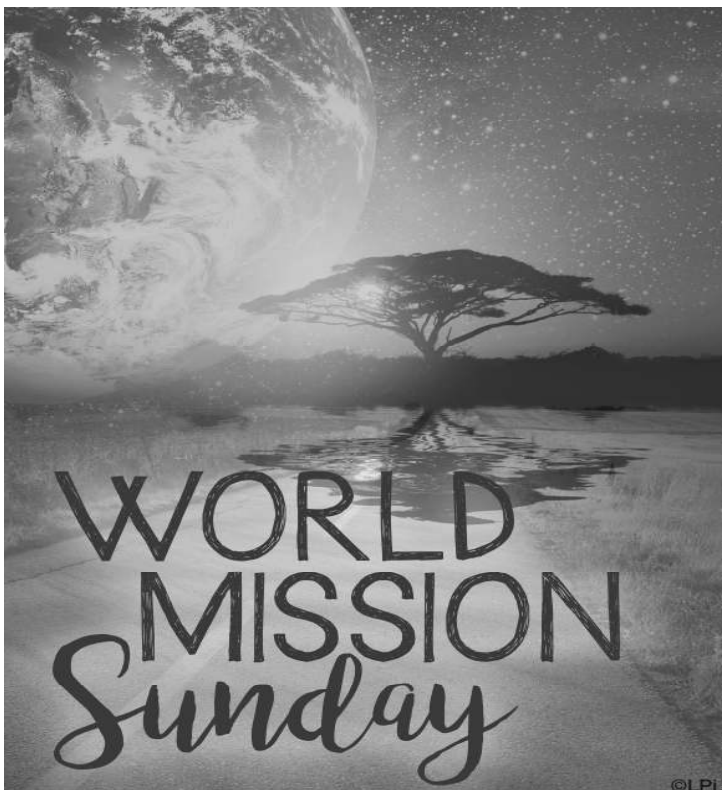
