from the pastor

Dear Friends,

At the height of the pandemic, both our school and parish were scrambling to try to make our buildings safe. As you well know, we addressed everything from cleanliness to our HVAC infrastructure. Our school knocked down walls and created new spaces for classrooms and instruction. Both St. Jude and St. Mary Churches were evaluated in the light of pandemic protocols and we addressed the air systems in both buildings. This was possible through the generosity and stewardship of our faithful parishioners, but there was also some needed outside help.

The Hartford Bishops Foundation gave us two grants totaling \$27,000.00 for the school and parish to address COVID issues and keep our parish safe. The grant to us and to many other parishes throughout this difficult year certainly underlined the Foundation's desire to make significant strategic investments in the spiritual and financial wellbeing of our Archdiocese and our local parish communities. We are grateful for the foundations's help and assistance during these difficult days.

Something that the COVID crisis affected on the archdiocesan level is the Synod. I am happy to announce that the concluding celebration of the Archdiocesan Synod "Grow and Go" will take place on Friday, August 13th at 6:30 PM at the Oakdale Theater in Wallingford. This joyous culminating event was postponed a few times during this past year. We are happy that this special occasion will be held on the inaugural Feast Day of Blessed Michael McGivney, a native son and exemplary priest of the Archdiocese of Hartford. Each parish is asked to send 30 representatives from the faith community. If you are interested in participating, please contact the parish office as soon as possible.


I am looking forward to the celebration of the Parish Festival on July 10.



The Directives for Liturgies in Churches of the Archdiocese of Hartford

General Guidelines:

May 19, 2021, our churches can reopen to 100% capacity with no need for any specific social distancing (https://portal.ct.gov/DECD/Content/Coronavirus-Business-Recovery/Sector-Rules-for-Reopen).

-There is still to be no Offertory procession bringing forward the gifts.

-The Sign of Peace can be announced and reinstituted but is only to be exchanged without touching.

- -The COVID-19 procedures for distributing Holy Communion will remain in place for now:
 - 1) Ministers of Holy Communion will sanitize their hands prior to distributing and will wear masks.
 - 2) Communicants will receive the consecrated host in their hand, step to the side, consume the host and return to their pew.
 - **3)** Communion on the tongue should continue to be discouraged for the sake of the health of others. Those who receive in this manner should receive only after everyone else has received.
