

EXPECTATIONS

What happens when you are fully expecting a great event and it doesn't occur? Perhaps at Christmas you have had your heart set on a particular gift and Santa had something different in mind for you; or you may have been anticipating a substantial raise in salary or a new and important position at work and it goes to someone else, hmmm! At moments like these, we can choose to become depressed, discouraged, even despairing or we can face it with hope knowing that somehow, we will survive.

The Jews in captivity at Babylon fully expected that the Messiah would come immediately when they were released. They were filled with hope and expectations. Second Isaiah is called "The book of Consolations." At the time of John the Baptist, good people were fully expecting the decisive intervention of God and the coming of the Messiah. When the Messiah came, the belief was that everything would be instantly perfect. There would be perfect peace, justice, the end of all suffering, no more death, no more pain or sorrow. However, they forgot one important part of the message: They must turn their lives around! They must repent and so must we. As we enter the second week of Advent, the teaching of the Gospel is that we must prepare for the Lord by a complete change of attitude. We must turn our lives around.

The second reading today reminds us that a thousand years in God's eyes are as a day. Following this time-sequence, it has only been two days since Jesus ascended to heaven to prepare a place for us. In this framework, Christ will return in glory very soon. So, let us never become discouraged, rather let's work on being the best version of ourselves and try to improve on those things in our lives that need our attention. Let's prepare for his coming with renewed faith, hope and love.

I hope that we all will use this time of preparation, this Advent Season, to prepare to celebrate the birth of our Savior and his coming again in glory.

Saint Paul, in the second reading, tells us to conduct ourselves in holiness and devotion, waiting for the day of the Lord.

In the Gospel reading we hear about Saint John the Baptist preparing the people for the coming of Christ.



What can we do to prepare for the coming of Jesus, which we remember especially at Christmas?

First, we should try to be holy like Saint Paul says. We should pray and do good. Then, we should make sure that we have repented of all our



sins, like Saint John the Baptist taught the people. Finally, we should tell people about Jesus! The first reading tells us, "Fear not to cry out and say to the cities of Judah: Here is your God!"




