

ARE YOU READY FOR THE JOURNEY?

As we journey into the Second Week of Lent, the Scriptures share with us Abraham's offering of his son. It's not a stretch for us to see the connection between the crucifixion of Jesus and God's command to Abraham to offer up his son Isaac as a sacrifice. As Jesus is loved by his father, so Isaac is loved by Abraham, his father. Both were in route to their death: Isaac carries the wood for the fire; Jesus carries the wood on the cross. Isaac's journey was three days. Jesus journey from death to life was three days.

Abraham's uncompromising faith allowed his son Isaac to be spared. Jesus broke the barrier of death to rise to new life. Abraham is faithfully following God's call on a path that is ripping out his heart and crushing his dreams. God is not really asking Abraham to sacrifice his son, but only the limiting attachments he has with his son: ego, security and privilege. Because Abraham is willing to sacrifice so much, God blesses him with a vision far beyond his dreams.

Can you imagine the disciples experience of the Transfiguration? Peter, James and John went up the mountain with a set world view, a perspective of who they were traveling with... Jesus. Their whole experience of Jesus changed. They saw him in a whole new light, with a new set of eyes, their vision was transfigured. Their world view changed. They now had new priorities. Sometimes spiritual directors will call the Abraham, Peter, James and John moments "aha" moments.

Is there something clouding your sight and keeping you from a much more Christ-centered world view? The readings invite us to more clearly see God's dream for us. It is beyond anything we could have ever imagined. How are you seeing your purpose in life?

For me, the trip up the mountain is uncertain faithfulness. Where is Jesus taking me? I'm comfortable where I'm at, but I'll go along. Then, there is clarity ... aha, now I know! But coming down the mountain means I have purpose and see the world with a new vision. During this Lenten journey, may we embrace the Christ vision with clarified purpose. Like those before us, God's vision will unfold far beyond our dreams.

Are you ready for the journey?



Jesus took Peter, James and John up a mountain. Suddenly His face became dazzling white, like the sun. He began to speak with Moses and Elijah, who appeared beside Him. The apostles were terrified. Peter said, "Lord, it is good for us to be here. Shall we build a tabernacle: one for You, one for Moses and one for Elijah?" Then a cloud came over them, and a voice came out of it and said, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him." Then only Jesus was there with them. Coming down the mountain, He told the apostles not to tell anyone what happened until after He rose from the dead.

Jesus Shows His Glory

Jesus knew He was going to die, and He knew the apostles were going to be afraid. So He decided to show some of them something that they would not be able to forget. He took Peter, James and John up a mountain and suddenly He became dazzlingly bright, like the sun! The apostles were terrified. Then Jesus began to talk with Moses and Elijah, who stood beside Him.

Afterwards, Jesus told Peter, James and John not to tell anyone what had happened until after He rose from the dead. They were confused because they didn't understand that Jesus had to die. But now they knew that Jesus was not just a normal man. They had seen some of the awesomeness of God.

Later on, when Jesus was taken away and killed, the apostles were very sad. But some of them knew something amazing about Jesus. Like those apostles, when we are having a hard time we just need to think about Jesus. He is awesome and amazing, and waiting for us to come to Him in Heaven. The bad times will come, but Jesus is always there- we just need to remember Him!
