Resurrection

Our liturgy today is full of images of life and death. These images are meant to help us realize the depth of God's love for us and help keep alive our hope of eternal life in heaven.

Our opening prayer speaks of the dying of Christ, which brought us salvation. God's plan to reconcile us to himself is revealed in Christ, whose death and resurrection have made eternal life in heaven possible for us.

In the preface of the Eucharistic prayer, we acknowledge that Christ's gift of the Sacraments can help bring us to everlasting life. When we open ourselves to the graces of the Sacraments, we are lifted up and aided in our desire to conform our lives to be more like Christ's. Finally the solemn blessing at the end of the Mass asks that God free us from every evil so that we may service him in our whole hearts, which is necessary for everlasting life.

When our lives are deadened because of sin, God stands ready to open our graves and let us rise from them and to raise us up to newer and more abundant life by his grace and by the power of the Holy Spirit. But God's promise of new life is not limited to the spiritual realm. Today's gospel reading of the raising of Lazarus shows that it includes a physical rising. It was Martha who first professed her belief in resurrection on the last day. She also believed that Jesus was the Son of God, while many others refused to believe in him, in spite of his signs he performed.

It was Jesus who said to the disciples, and then to all those mourning, that the illness of Lazarus would not end in death. He said it would serve the glory of God, and that the Son of God would be gloried through it. It was Jesus who raised Lazarus from the dead so that more people would come to believe that Jesus is the Son of God.

Lent is a good time to let God roll away the stones that cover our graves of sin, so that Jesus can summon us to come out and enter into a newer and fuller life with him.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.



*Unless a grain falls to the ground and dies...*




Jesus knew He was going to die soon. It made Him sad, but He knew that He had to do it. He told the apostles, "Unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit." Because Jesus died, we can be freed from our sins and live!

Have you ever tried planting seeds? The little seeds are hard and dry and seem to be dead. We put them into some damp soil, and cover them up. After a few days you can see little sprouts coming out of the soil, and soon there are little plants growing! Maybe your Mom or Dad can help you plant some seeds this spring.



Our Lord was telling His friends that He had to be like a seed. He would die and be buried, and then after a few days, come back to life! And like a plant that grows and produces more seed, the Church would grow from Jesus and bring other holy people, saints, into the world. Saints are people that are ready to give up their good things and even their lives for love of God, just like Jesus.
