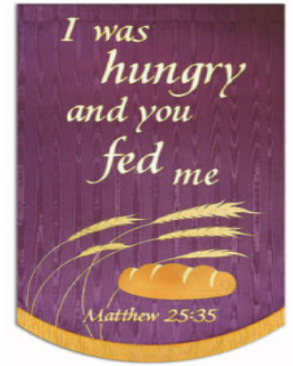

### LENTEN REMINDERS

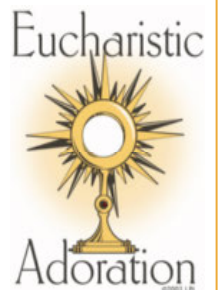
- ◆ Lent began on Ash Wednesday and continues through the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 14.
- ◆ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.
- ◆ Fasting is obligatory for those who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal.
- ◆ Abstinence from meat is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year. This is also obligatory for all Fridays in Lent.

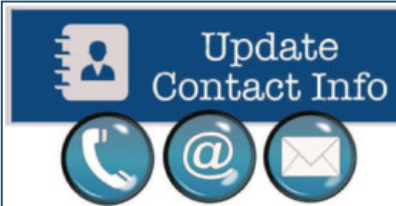

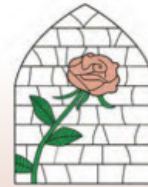
