GOSPEL READING REFLEXION

28TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME.



We see this in today's Gospel reading. Jesus tries teaching this to the man who comes to him, as He sees that the wealthy man is walking on the path of salvation but for this attachment to the wealth he has hoarded. Jesus asks him to act in the role of steward rather than a prince,

redirecting the material to those who truly need it, and to trust in Him to provide while the man continues on the path. Instead, the man turns away, trusting more in his wealth than in Jesus, the Word of God. Wealth becomes a trap, not because it's sinful in and of itself to be wealthy, but because it leads us to believe that we are greater than the Lord — while at the same time despairing of our future without it. This is why Jesus says that it is more difficult for a camel to pass through the eye of the needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.



♦ Vemos esto en la lectura del evangelio de hoy. Jesús intenta enseñarle esto al hombre que viene a él, ya que ve que el hombre rico está caminando por el camino de la salvación, pero por este apego a la riqueza que ha acumulado. Jesús le pide que actúe en el papel de mayordomo en lugar de un príncipe, redirigiendo el material a aquellos que realmente lo necesitan, y que confíe en Él para proveer mientras el hombre continúa en el camino. En cambio, el hombre se da la vuelta, confiando más en su riqueza que en Jesús, la Palabra de Dios. La riqueza se convierte en una trampa, no porque sea pecaminoso en sí mismo para ser rico, sino porque nos lleva a creer que somos más grandes que el Señor, al mismo tiempo que nos desesperamos de nuestro futuro sin ella. Por eso, Jesús dice que es más difícil que un camello pase por el ojo de la aguja que un hombre rico que entre en el reino de los cielos.

♦ Nous le voyons dans la lecture de l'Évangile d'aujourd'hui. Jésus tente d'enseigner cela à l'homme qui vient à lui, car il voit que l'homme riche marche sur le chemin du salut, sans cet attachement à la richesse qu'il a amassée. Jésus lui demande de jouer le rôle d'intendant plutôt que de prince, en redirigeant le matériel vers ceux qui en ont vraiment besoin et en lui faisant confiance pour que celui-ci pourvoie aux besoins pendant que l'homme poursuit son chemin. Au lieu de cela, l'homme se détourne, faisant davantage confiance à sa richesse qu'à Jésus, la Parole de Dieu. La richesse devient un piège, non pas parce qu'elle est pécheur en soi, mais parce qu'elle nous porte à croire que nous sommes plus grands que le Seigneur - tout en désespérant de notre avenir sans elle. C'est pourquoi Jésus dit qu'il est plus difficile pour un chameau de passer à travers le chas de l'aiguille que pour un homme riche d'entrer dans le royaume des cieux.

Cresci has glorified the Lord with his musical gifts and now requires our prayers as he embarks on the next chapter of his life. Dr. Cresci has said that it's "now time... to put my wife Elizabeth and me first: to spend whatever time I have left on this earth to reflect and appreciate the past, while enjoying the present and to plan for our future together."

Dr. Cresci has been a great role model in our church. He has selflessly devoted an entire lifetime to enhancing worship through his liturgical ministry. He also is responsible for significant financial growth within our church. He has garnered grants and awards for our church totaling 1.1 million dollars! This money has been used to restore murals on the altar, replace the roof, as well as restore our historic organ — which, as you may know, has received international acclaim.

Dr. Cresci has been involved in our parish in one form or another for over half a century! His music has inspired us during mass, helped us prayer, and ultimately brought us closer to God.
