GOSPEL READING REFLEXION

29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME.



In today's Gospel, James and John ask to be given seats of honor when Jesus enters into his glory. Once again, the disciples seem to be selective in what they hear Jesus say. They want to share Jesus' glory, but do not appear to understand that his glory will be preceded by his suffering. Jesus notes their lack of understanding and predicts the suffering

they will endure for the sake of the Gospel. Jesus says that the honor they seek is not his to give. When the other ten hear what James and John have asked, Mark reports that they are indignant. Jesus takes the opportunity to teach them. Jesus explains the importance of service and sacrifice in the life of a disciple. In particular, he seems to be preparing the Twelve for their leadership roles in the emerging Christian community.

- ◆ En el Evangelio de hoy, Santiago y Juan piden que se les otorguen lugares de honor cuando Jesús entre en su gloria. Una vez más, los discípulos parecen ser selectivos en lo que escuchan decir a Jesús. Quieren compartir la gloria de Jesús, pero no parecen entender que su gloria será precedida por su sufrimiento. Jesús nota su falta de comprensión y predice el sufrimiento que soportarán por el bien del Evangelio. Jesús dice que el honor que buscan no es suyo. Cuando los otros diez escuchan lo que James y John han preguntado, Mark informa que están indignados. Jesús aprovecha la oportunidad para enseñarles. Jesús explica la importancia del servicio y el sacrificio en la vida de un discípulo. En particular, parece estar preparando a los Doce para sus roles de liderazgo en la comunidad cristiana emergente.

- ◆ Dans l'Évangile d'aujourd'hui, Jacques et Jean demandent à être placés dans des sièges d'honneur lorsque Jésus entrera dans sa gloire. Une fois encore, les disciples semblent être sélectifs dans ce qu'ils entendent dire de Jésus. Ils veulent partager la gloire de Jésus, mais ne semblent pas comprendre que sa gloire sera précédée par ses souffrances. Jésus note leur manque de compréhension et prédit les souffrances qu'ils vont endurer pour l'amour de l'Évangile. Jésus dit que l'honneur qu'ils recherchent ne lui appartient pas. Quand les dix autres entendent ce que James et John ont demandé, Mark rapporte qu'ils sont indignés. Jésus en profite pour leur enseigner. Jésus explique l'importance du service et du sacrifice dans la vie d'un disciple. En particulier, il semble préparer les Douze à assumer leurs rôles de leadership dans la communauté chrétienne émergente.

It is always a sad affair to lose a team member who is so dedicated and talented at what they do. For forty two years, Dr. Alfred E. Cresci has glorified the Lord with his musical gifts and now requires our prayers as he embarks on the next chapter of his life. Dr. Cresci has said that it's "now time... to put my wife Elizabeth and me first: to spend whatever time I have left on this earth to reflect and appreciate the past, while enjoying the present and to plan for our future together."

Dr. Cresci has been a great role model in our church. He has selflessly devoted an entire lifetime to enhancing worship through his liturgical ministry. He also is responsible for significant financial growth within our church. He has garnered grants and awards for our church totaling 1.1 million dollars! This money has been used to restore murals on the altar, replace the roof, as well as restore our historic organ — which, as you may know, has received international acclaim.

While the loss of Dr. Cresci in his duties is certainly immense, let us take the time to celebrate both the man and the musician. Dr. Cresci has been involved in our parish in one form or another for over half a century! His music has inspired us during mass, helped us prayer, and ultimately brought us closer to God.
