GOSPEL READING REFLEXION

31ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME.



The question posed in today's Gospel requires Jesus to interpret the Law of Moses. The Mosaic Law consists of the Ten Commandments and many additional commandments, numbering into the hundreds. For a devout Jew, adherence to the

Mosaic Law is an expression of faithfulness to God's covenant with Israel. The ranking of these commandments was regularly debated among the teachers of the Law. Jesus was not the only Jewish religious teacher to connect these two commandments, love of God and love of neighbor. Both of these commandments were central elements of the religious tradition that Jesus learned from his Jewish community.

Jesus' response to his questioners proposed an integral connection between these two aspects of the Jewish Law. Love of God finds its expression in our love for our neighbor.

Many believe, however, that this connection was heard in a new and fresh way when spoken by Jesus.

- ♦ La pregunta planteada en el Evangelio de hoy requiere que Jesús interprete la Ley de Moisés. La Ley Mosaica consiste en los Diez Mandamientos y muchos mandamientos adicionales, que suman cientos. Para un judío devoto, la adhesión a la Ley Mosaica es una expresión de fidelidad al pacto de Dios con Israel. El ranking de estos mandamientos se debatía regularmente entre los maestros de la ley. Jesús no fue el único maestro religioso judío que conectó estos dos mandamientos, el amor a Dios y el amor al prójimo. Ambos mandamientos fueron elementos centrales de la tradición religiosa que Jesús aprendió de su comunidad judía. La respuesta de Jesús a sus interrogadores propuso una conexión integral entre estos dos aspectos de la Ley judía. El amor de Dios encuentra su expresión en nuestro amor por nuestro prójimo. Muchos creen, sin embargo, que esta conexión se escuchó de una manera nueva y fresca cuando fue hablada por Jesús.

Dear Brothers and
Sisters in Christ,

As you are well aware, we have two festivals honoring the dead to celebrate this week. All Saints' Day is on Thursday, November 1st, and All Souls' Day is on Friday, November 2nd.

We will be having mass on BOTH days at 8am as well as a 7:30pm Trilingual.

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. Although millions, or even billions of people may already be saints, All Saints' Day observances tend to focus on known saints --that is those recognized in the canon of the saints by the Catholic Church.

All Souls' Day is a holy day set aside for honoring the dead. This day is associated with the doctrine that the souls of the faithful who at death have not been cleansed from the temporal punishment due to venial sins and from attachment to mortal sins cannot immediately attain the beatific vision in heaven, and that they may be helped to do so by prayer and by the sacrifice of the Mass.

As Catholics, it's important for us to celebrate both days. Participation in the mass is the best way to honor those who have faithfully departed!
