New Weekend Mass Schedule

Since a further threat of the spread of COVID-19 has arisen, the following additional actions are now in place for all Masses throughout the Hartford Archdiocese:

- A separate section of the church (the left side of the left wing of the church) will be marked and reserved for those people wearing masks who do not want to sit near those not wearing masks.
- All Eucharistic Ministers serving at Mass must be vaccinated and will continue wearing masks while distributing Holy Communion.

Canned soup, tuna, tomatoes, ravioli, stew, chili, baked beans, pork and beans and pasta sauce.


We will continue collecting these items during the month of August. Bins are located inside the front door of the church and in the lobby of the parish center.

fitting one more thing on your plate? We used to think that way, too. But then we joined *Walking with Purpose* (WWP) and everything changed.


