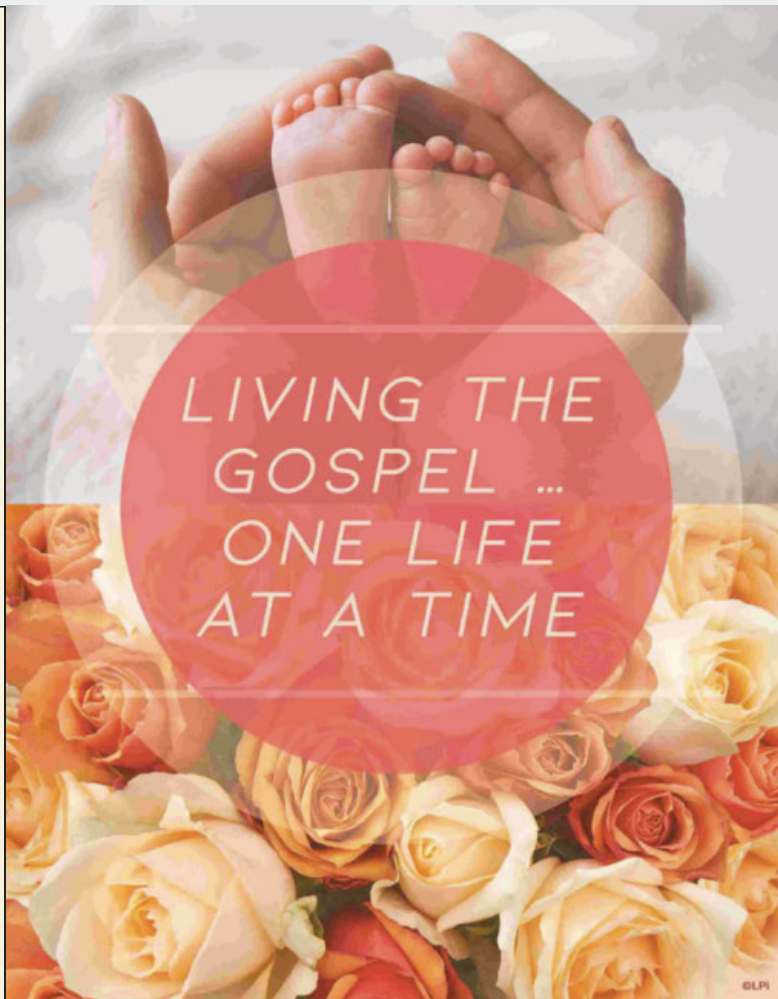

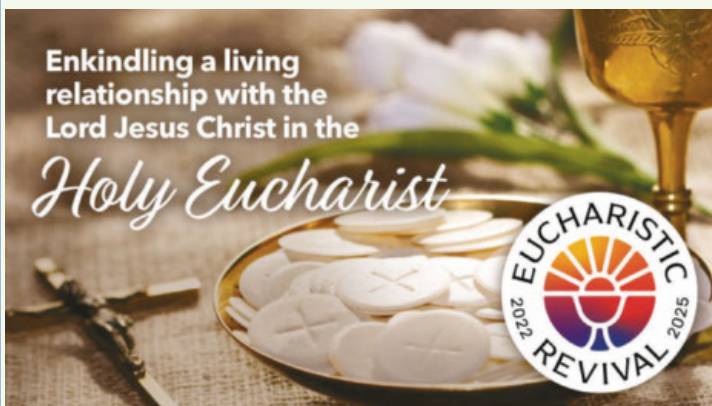
Jesus Gave Us the Greatest Bible Study of All Time
