**From the  
Pastor's Desk**



**Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time  
(Year B)**

Sunday, October 7, 2018

God is the creator, redeemer, and sanctifier of all humanity. Today's readings lead us to recognize the communion of God in love. The Father sent the Son, whom he made a "little less than the angels" so that, by dying and rising, he would be crowned in glory. This intimate communion the Holy Spirit creates becomes present as a sign in every sacrament the Church celebrates. In today's Gospel, Jesus affirms the union of man and woman before God, a sign the Church has declared as the sacrament of marriage. Faced with the many options for human relationships that society offers us today, we can neither forget the origin of the human family nor the holiness of married life. It is important to have the various groups of the community, especially the youth groups, discuss the significant value of Christian marriage.

**LECTIO DIVINA**

What is *lectio Divina*? This is a technical term taken from Latin meaning "divine reading." *Lectio Divina* is a method of praying the Scriptures either alone or in a group. It is a very ancient practice and is based on the idea that one does not really know Scripture until one memorizes it and makes it prayerfully personal. *Lectio Divina* is NOT Bible study, rather it is a personal encounter with the Word of God. Sometimes it may be helpful to know the context of the scripture passage in order to understand its meaning, but in *Lectio Divina* we do not worry about who the author is, when it was written and why. Instead we let the reading impact our prayer and our lives. We encounter not the word of man, but the Word of God. This method was used throughout the time of the ancient church and the Middle Ages (100-1450). After that it was the practice usually of monks

and nuns rather than ordinary Christians. Since and because of the Second Vatican Council the Church has been unearthing the ancient practices of the Church in the way we celebrate Mass (using the language of the people, for example) and in the way we encounter Scripture in its privileged places—in the sacraments and in the public proclamation during the Mass. And now we concentrate on private prayer using Scripture. There is a definite method ( 4 steps) of *Lectio Divina* which we will learn over the next four weeks: Step 1 *lectio*; Step 2 *meditatio*; Step 3 *oratio*; and step 4 *contemplatio*. If you want to know more, just google "Lectio Divina" or check out the website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and read the section entitled "Ever ancient, Ever New: the Art and Practice of *Lectio Divina*."

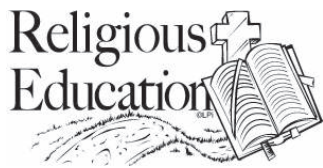
