

Genesis 18: 20-32

We sometimes confuse God's mercy with an indulgent tolerance that is not part of His character. Jesus wept over the crowds in Jerusalem who were frantically pursuing the wrong goals, and He was angry at the misuse of the Temple, a house of prayer. In this conversation between God and Abraham about the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah, Abraham pleads for mercy for the sake of the innocent. What better, more conscientious father could God have chosen for his people!

God shows His compassion in agreeing to save the cities, despite the way they have sinned against Him, for the sake of only ten just men.

God's standards are high, and we must not underestimate them. They require self-discipline, self-control, rigor as well as forgiveness and understanding. We do not honor Him by allowing evil to flourish around us or in us in the name of freedom and tolerance. We shall be truly free only if we live as God's people, on His terms of disciplined love.

Colossians 2: 12-14

Seeing our sinfulness and our inability to rise above it, God intervenes at His own expense to cancel the great debt of sin. In doing this, He does not lower His standards and accepts our dismal record. After all, He knows our potential and longs for us to know happiness and peace. So the only way He can cancel the debt is by paying it Himself, in full, in the agony of the Passion.

Luke 11: 1-13

The disciples could see that Jesus' praying was an altogether different experience from the praying they knew. What He taught was not so much a form of words as a new relationship with God. We, as God's children, can trustingly ask for and expect to receive good things from our heavenly Father.

It is something helpful to think of the Lord's prayer, consisting of headings, and to spend time meditating on each phrase, remembering that God is our living Father and we are conversing with Him as His loving children.

Registration forms which can be obtained in the Parish Office and must be signed by Father Gagne and returned prior to September 19th.




ABBA, Thank you for summer




