Pastoral Reflections from Father Anthony 4rd SUNDAY OF LENT

In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to reflect on God's tremendous love as a father with two children, with two different lifestyles. He loves them both, but both seem to have failed him.

After the younger son leaves, the father always looks forward to his return and he never stops living in hope. When the son returned, the father saw him before he could see his father. Although the son was sick, stinking, treacherous, it did not make his father stay away, "He was still a long way off, and his father saw him" (Lk 15:20a). The overflowing love made my father's footsteps hurry. Father's arms were too big and his kiss was passionate, "He was moved with pity, ran out, hugged him and kissed him" (15:20b). The finest robe, new sandals, rings, music, feast, dancing: all this is just to let everyone know that no matter what, he is still my child. As long as he returns, the father has forgotten all about his sinful past, "For this son of mine was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is now found" (15:24).

In contrast to the younger son, the older son is diligent and hardworking. He is too filial, always obedient to his father for every little bit. He does not lead a life of pleasures, is not extravagant, just takes care of the farm. Everyone sees him as an exemplary person. But the incident of the return of his younger brother has revealed his true self, a man of power, greed, lack of compassion by the fact that he blamed his father: "Look, all these years I served you and not once did I disobey your orders; yet you never gave me even a young goat to feast on with my friends" (Lk 15:29). For he cannot understand why his father is so weak and so tolerant that it is unfair to him. So, he can't be happy with his father, neither with his younger brother. Therefore, he refused to enter the house!

It turned out that both sons were different and the same. Both were outside their father's house, accepting hunger. The younger son was not happy with his father, so he left. The older son could not share his father's happiness, so he did not enter. Both need to repent. Both need to return to receive love, joy, and a new vitality.

But returning is not easy. Nobody wants to admit that they go astray or are lost. The older son needs to remove his pride to joyfully enter the house. The second son needs to be humble to dare to meet his father and his family in the state of being devastated. To return, one needs to stand up or leave one's place. Giving up is painful but happiness is great. The greatest happiness is not material possessions, but the discovery that we have a place in our God's heart and are loved by everyone. God loves us though we

are spoiled and unfaithful. God loves us not because we are good at work. God loves us only because we are his children. He does not want to lose anyone.

The Journey of Lent is the journey of repentance to return to God, returning to a love. Returning requires us to open our arms to embrace others. They may be husband, wife, beloved ones, so on, and together we repent and return. Therefore, let us ask God to draw us back to God every day, by helping us to regulate deviant passions, unrighteous ambitions, selfishness and greed so that we may be more loving, more generous, more tolerant and gentler to those around us. Amen.


