

Pastoral Reflections from Father Anthony 5th SUNDAY OF LENT

In today's Gospel, the scribes and Pharisees bring the woman, who was caught in adultery to Jesus to trap him. They said to him, "Now in the law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So, what do you say?" (Jn 8:5). If he forgave the woman, he would be against the law of Moses. If he said she would be stoned, he acted against his own teachings of mercy, compassion and forgiveness.

When people demand to stone others, they consider themselves without sin and have the right to condemn sinners. But when they discover that they are also sinners, they do not dare to condemn others. The discovery has to be made by looking within oneself. An unexpected turn of events came from the Lord's invitation when he asked the crowd to look at themselves, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her" (Jn 8:7). For who dares to boast of being sinless?

Therefore, demanding to stone the woman, they want to frame her life in the past. The past was sealed with sin. People often evaluate, judge, and act on that past. Jesus did not accept their view and evaluation. He is not complicit with sin.

"Go and from now on do not sin anymore" (Jn 8:11b). Jesus recognized her sin. He did not condemn nor commute her, but planted in her heart an open love by opening for her a new way of life. That is the repentance to become the children of God. She welcomed it and went home filled with the joy of conversion because she úra determined to make her life better.

God, who opens the gateway for human happiness, does not lock human life and human history in their sinful past. For instance, Levi, Zacchaeus, Magdalene, Augustine and many others were the people that God gave a bright future when they dared to strain forward to follow him as Paul described: "Just one thing: forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead" (Phil 3:13). For St. Paul, forgetting the way of the past was persecution of the Church of God. Straining forward is to become God's instrument, an apostle of the Gentiles. He has lived and died for this conviction.

In other words, where there is love, there is rich life. Where there is forgiveness there is peace. And so, love does not know how to condemn, but is always open to new life to rise up. With Jesus' forgiveness, we can understand that the worthiness of human beings is not in the past but in the future, not what they were but in what they will be. With Jesus' forgiveness we have the peace of mind

to close our sinful past to start a new future, walking in God's love and trust.

"Neither do I condemn you. Go and from now on do not sin anymore." Following the example of Jesus, let us open the way for hope, forgiveness and life to rise up. But first and foremost, we must start to do it now for our families and communities. Amen.

In their book, Miracles of the Eucharist, authors Bob and Penny Lord recount a number of Eucharistic miracles from around the world. One in particular took place in a church in the town of Lanciano in Italy. It was in the 700's A.D. that the bread and wine from the Eucharist became actual human flesh and blood. This flesh and blood have been left in their natural state exposed to normal atmospheric conditions and without the addition of any chemical preservatives. They have been tested many times, most recently in 1970, and have been found to be real human flesh and blood type AB.

Anyone interested in, or questioning, the reality of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist will find this to be a very interesting book. It would make a wonderful Easter gift for oneself or for someone who is going through doubt.

Also! If you or a loved one is doubtful, pray to Blessed Carlo Acutis (Model of Holiness) who lived for Christ. There is a website that explains about this young holy man's life who died at the age of 15 in 2006 – www.miracolieucaristici.org. It is worth taking the time to view, read and listen to!


