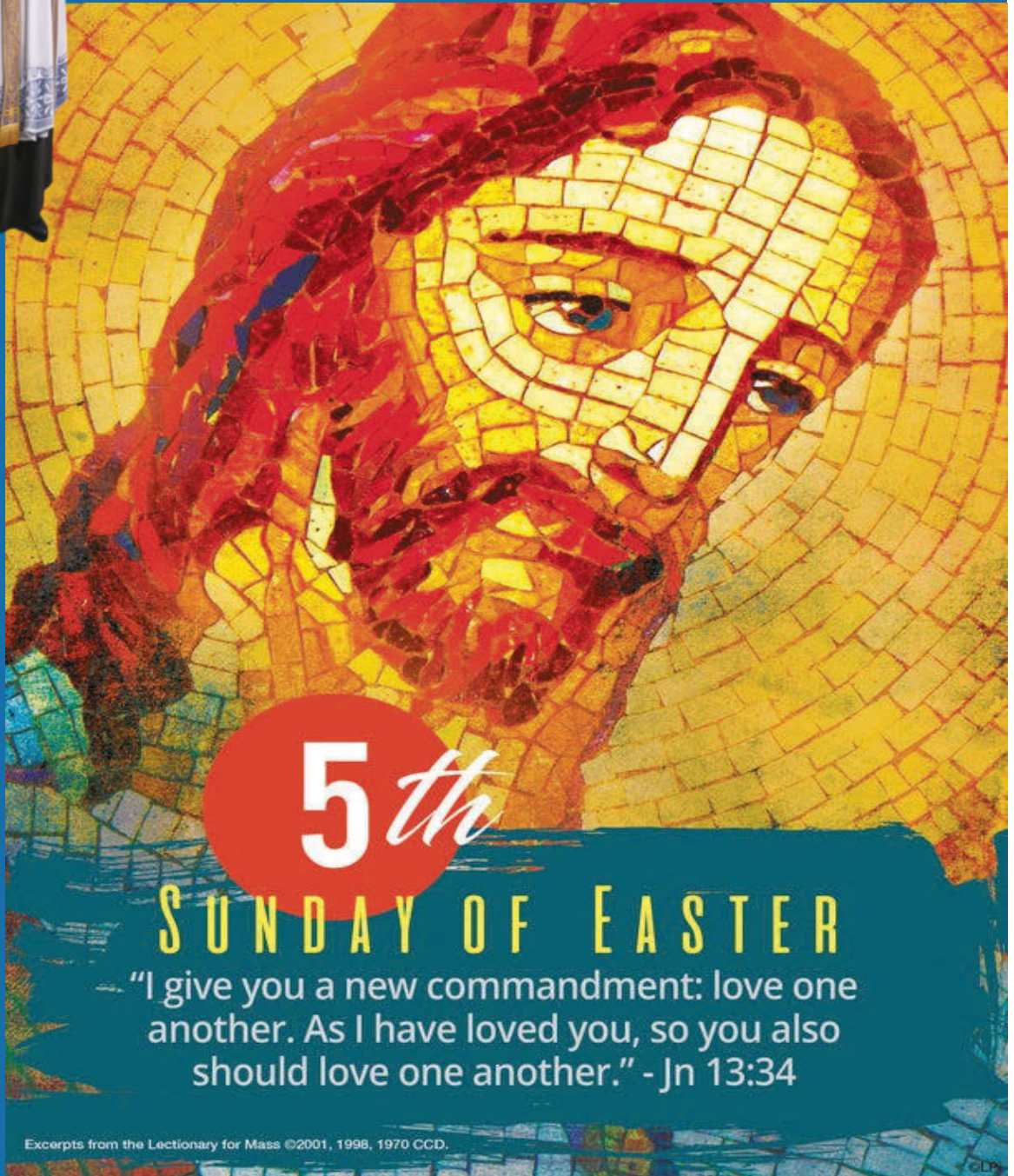

CEMETERY RULES

READINGS & OBSERVANCES

To allow for proper care and maintenance of the grounds and to provide for the safety of the cemetery attendant, the following rules apply:

Items permitted in the cemetery:

- Decorations firmly mounted on headstones or monument bases.
- Vigil lamps and holding rods inserted in the ground *immediately next to the monument base*.
- Small military, American, or decorative flags provided they are placed in approved metal holders/hangers and inserted in the ground *immediately on either side of the monument base*. (Military/American flags for Memorial Day may be inserted in the ground *immediately in front of the monument base* .

Please note items NOT permitted in the cemetery:

- Decorations not securely fastened to the headstone or monument base.
 - Shepherd's crooks or other plant hangers.
 - Personal trees, shrubs, plants, or flowers planted on the cemetery grounds.
 - Landscaping materials such as crushed rock, mulch, etc.
 - Items which are inappropriate or which may endanger visitors or the attendant.
- St. John Vianney Parish Cemeteries reserve the right and assume the responsibility of caring for the whole cemetery including the grave sites. This is funded by perpetual care. Included are:

- Initial grading and re-grading of graves.
 - Initial seeding and reseeded with lawn grass.
 - Mowing the grass and trimming around the monuments as needed.
- All work performed in the cemetery will only be done by the contracted caretakers. QUESTIONS? Please call the Parish Office at 834-5656.

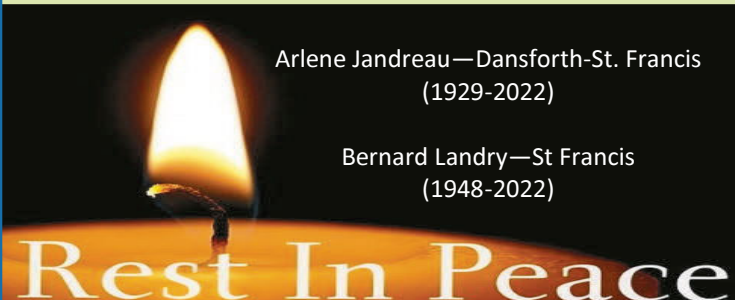
