

CEMETERY RULES Readings for the week of May 15, 2022

To allow for proper care and maintenance of the grounds and to provide for the safety of the cemetery attendant, the following rules apply:

Items permitted in the cemetery:

- Decorations firmly mounted on headstones or monument bases.
- Vigil lamps and holding rods inserted in the ground *immediately next to the monument base*.

• Small military, American, or decorative flags provided they are placed in approved metal holders/hangers and inserted in the ground *immediately on either side of the monument base*. (Military/American flags for Memorial Day may be inserted in the ground *immediately in front of the monument base*.

- Please note items NOT permitted in the cemetery:
- Decorations not securely fastened to the headstone or monument base.
- Shepherd's crooks or other plant hangers.
- Personal trees, shrubs, plants, or flowers planted on the cemetery grounds.
- · Landscaping materials such as crushed rock, mulch, etc.
- Items which are inappropriate or which may endanger visitors or the attendant.

St. John Vianney Parish Cemeteries reserve the right and assume the responsibility of caring for the whole cemetery including the grave sites. This is funded by perpetual care. Included are:

- Initial grading and re-grading of graves.
- Initial seeding and reseeding with lawn grass.
- Mowing the grass and trimming around the monuments as needed.

All work performed in the cemetery will only be done by the contracted caretakers. QUESTIONS? Please call the Parish Office at 834-5656.


